This essay was written by an Upper Intermediate level student who required a 6.5 result.

- The main problem occurred with Content as he answered the question incorrectly.
- His paragraph structure needs attention with regard to <u>writing clear main and</u> <u>supporting ideas</u>. He also needs to focus on learning and using the correct linking phrases.
- Some improvements are required with vocabulary, although a lot of these mistakes could be avoided if the writing is checked carefully before submitting.
- Finally, to improve the grammar score some accurate passive structures should be included, and again the writing should be carefully checked for prepositions, articles and other basic mistakes.
