This essay was written by an Upper Intermediate level student who required a 6.5 result.

- The main problem occurred with Content as he [answered the question incorrectly](#).
- His paragraph structure needs attention with regard to [writing clear main and supporting ideas](#). He also needs to focus on learning and using the correct linking phrases.
- Some improvements are required with vocabulary, although a lot of these mistakes could be avoided if the writing is checked carefully before submitting.
- Finally, to improve the grammar score some accurate passive structures should be included, and again the writing should be carefully checked for prepositions, articles and other basic mistakes.
