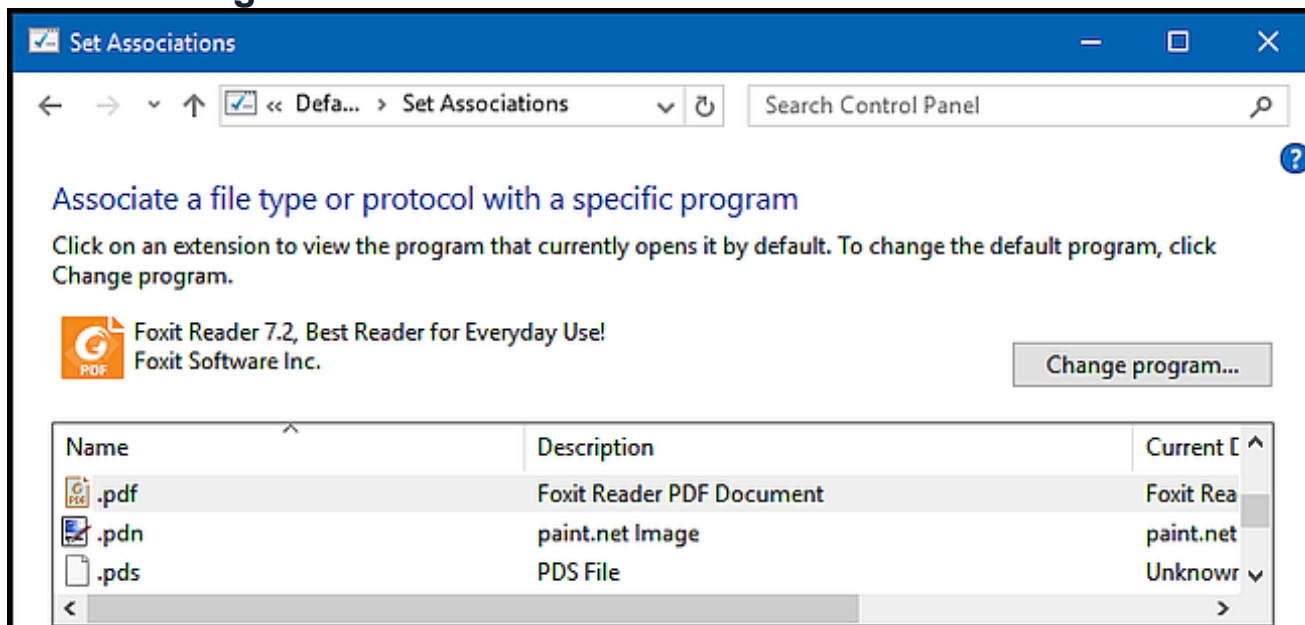


How to Change the Default PDF Reader in Windows 10



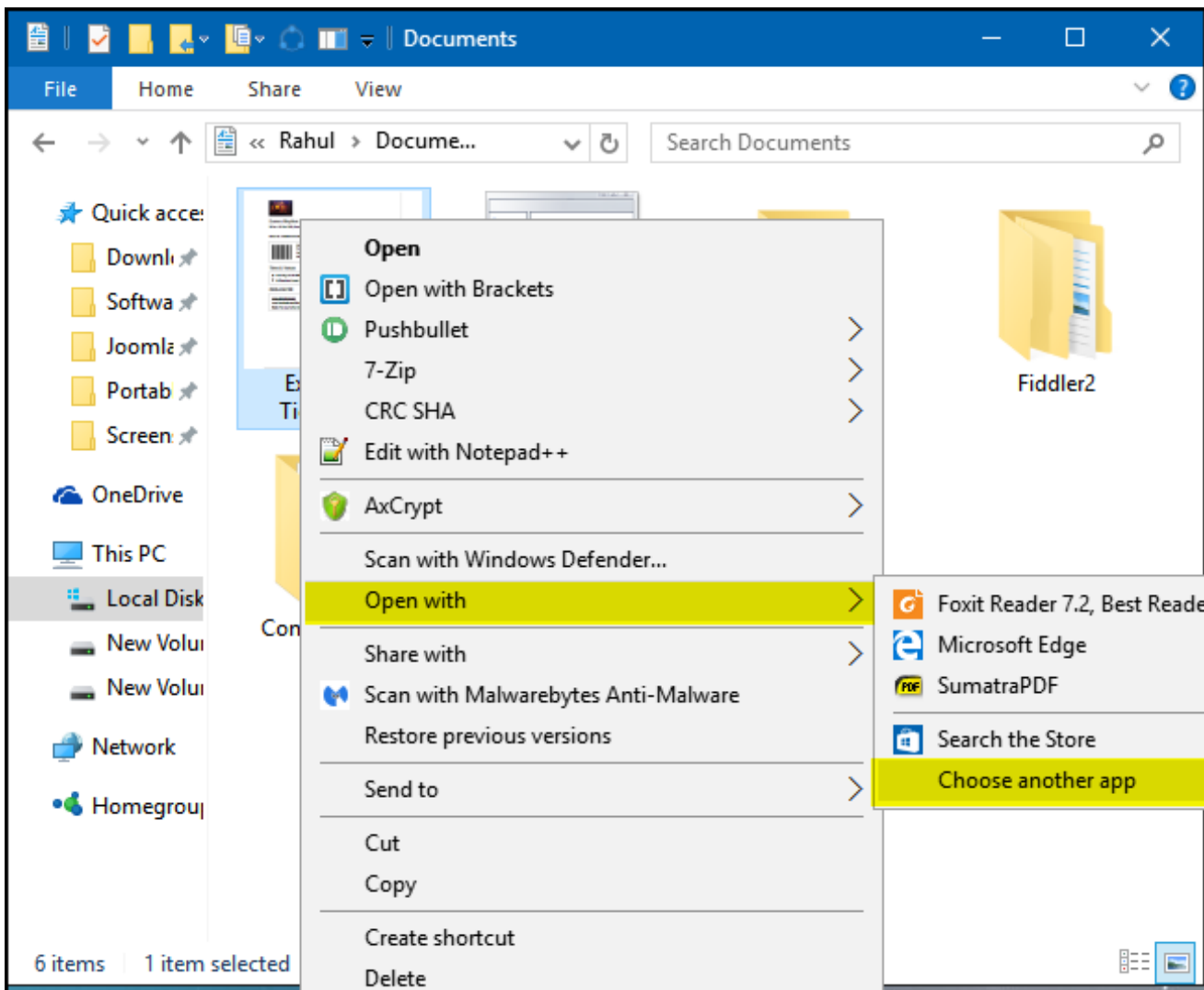
Microsoft Edge is not only the default web browser in Windows 10 but also the default PDF reader. This is defin good thing as we can finally view PDF files without having to install third-party apps, but it's more of a basic PDF reader.

If you prefer to have a feature-rich application as the default PDF reader instead of Edge, then you have plenty options to choose from. In this article, we'll show you how to change the default PDF reader in Windows 10.

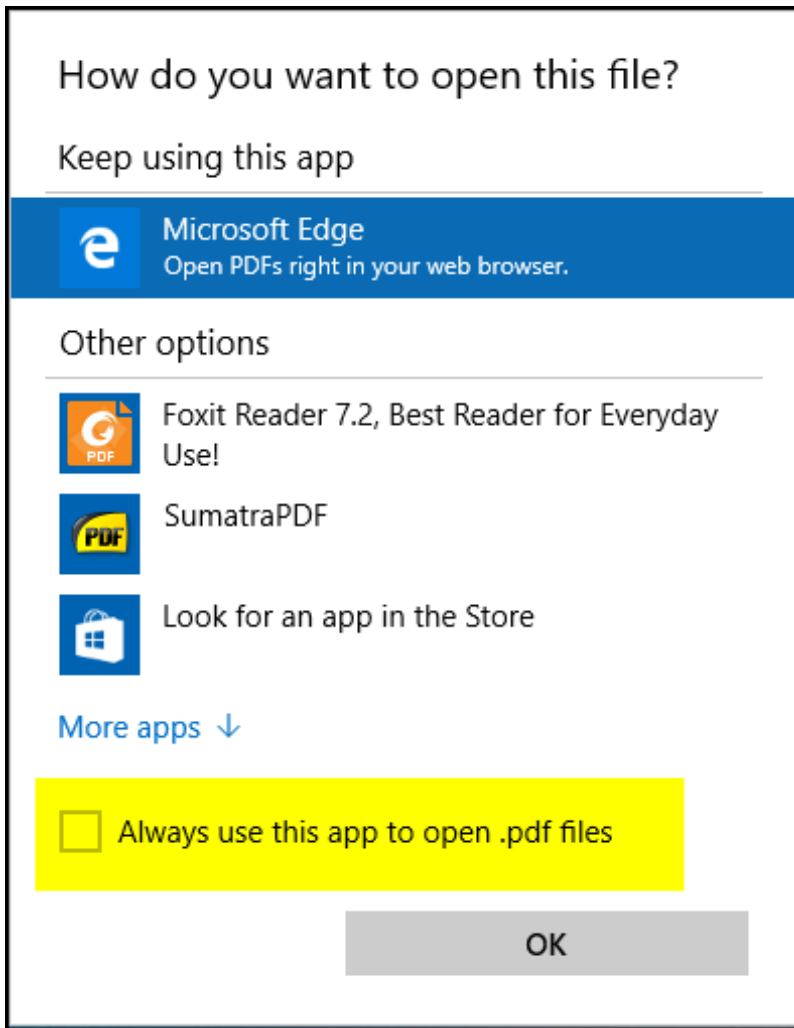
Change the Default by Using Open With in File Explorer

Open File Explorer and navigate to a folder containing your PDF file. Right-click on a file and choose "Open with Choose another app".

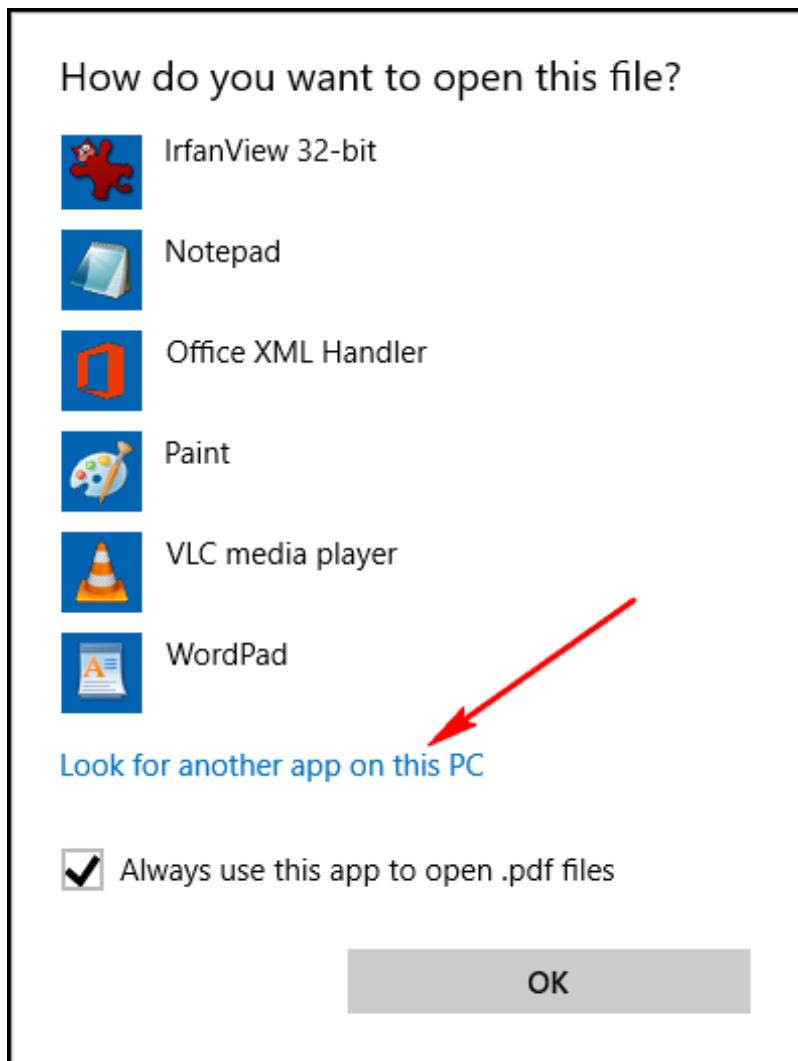
Smartlabtools PDF's interactive features will only work with Adobe Acrobat, Acrobat Reader, or newer Acrobat DC



A pop-up will appear that will let you choose a program for just one time. Or you can also select the “Always use this app” link to make it permanent. From this window, choose the default PDF reader of your choice.

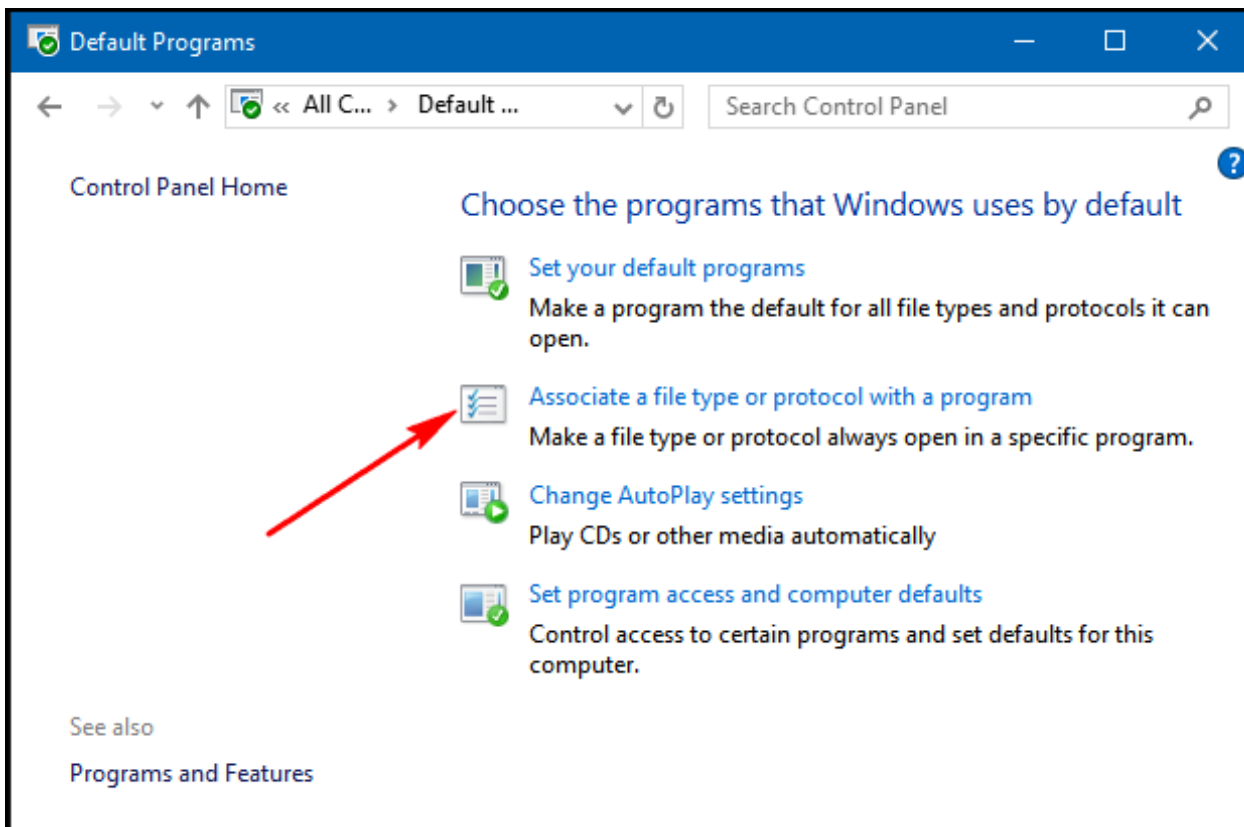


If the default app is not listed in this window, then you can select a different program located in your PC. Click “I apps”, select an app or scroll down to see “Look for another app in this PC” link. Click this link to browse to the program that you want to set as the default PDF reader, and choose the “Open” button to set it as the default.

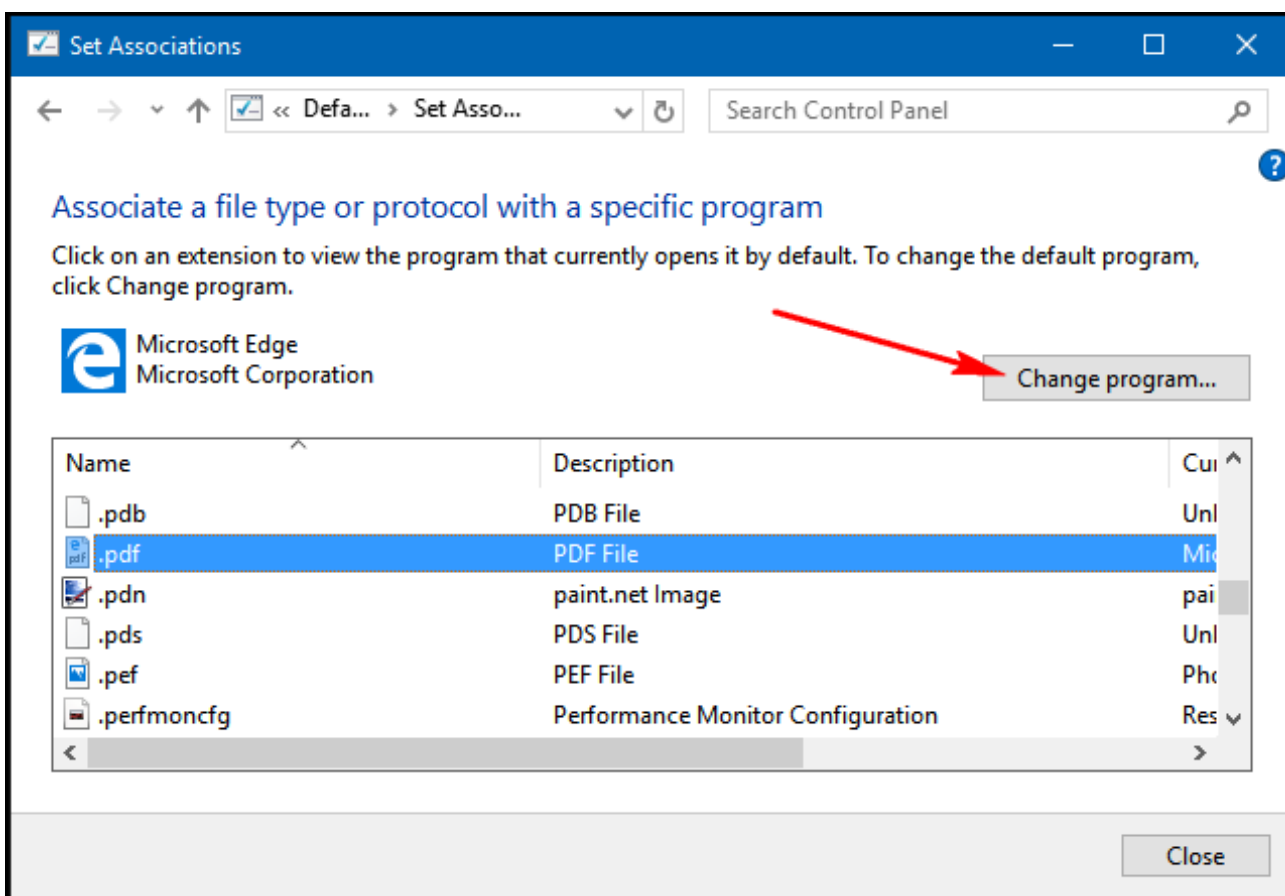


Change the Default by Using Default Programs in Control Panel

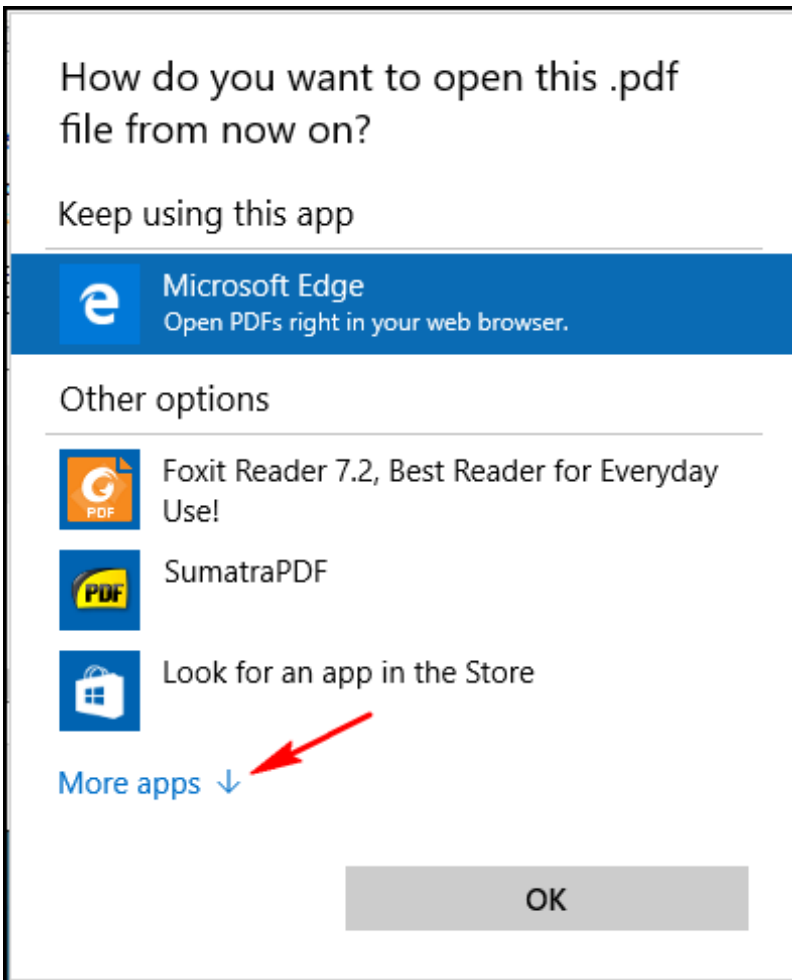
Open Control Panel (icon view) and select “Default Programs”. Click the link labelled “Associate a file type or pr with a program”, and wait for a couple of seconds to load all file types.



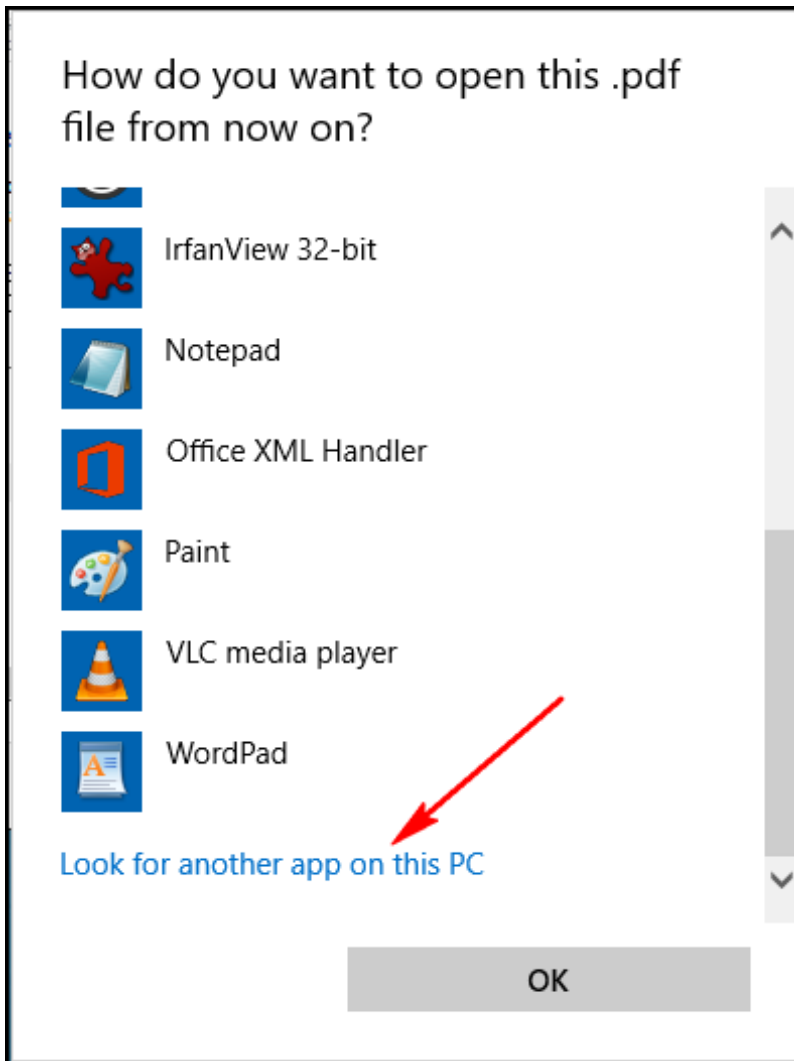
Scroll down the list to see .PDF entry. Click on “.PDF” entry, and then click the “Change program” button.



A pop-up will appear that will let you choose an app from the list.



If the default app is not listed in this window, then you can select a different program located in your PC. Click “I apps”, and select an app or scroll down to see “Look for another app in this PC” link. Click this link to browse to program that you want to set as the default PDF reader, and choose the “Open” button to set it as the default.
