"Let the little children come to me."

This may look familiar. It is something that I had written a year or two back, but I found it worth repeating.

As sponsors, in Baptism, we are asked "to promise to nurture the child, being baptized, in the Christian faith as we are empowered by God's Spirit, and to help him/her live in the covenant of baptism and in communion with the church."

And, "as people of God, we promise to support the child and pray for him/her in their new life in Christ."

Worshiping with children can be noisy and messy. Blessed be the parents that bring their children. But the real blessing is that the kids are worshiping with us, maybe even the first time. So, are we fulfilling our promise to support these children in their life in Christ? It is our utmost responsibility to support families and children in worship.

The command to love is the most repeated command in the New Testament. Every member is a <u>host</u> and not a <u>guest</u>. Making visitors feel welcome is primarily the responsibility of members, not the nebulous "church." Treat first time visitors as <u>guests of God</u>, not <u>strangers</u>. Greet children at <u>their level</u>, and let children be <u>children</u>.

Children are the future of the Church. If we want our children, grandchildren, nieces, and nephews to worship and know Christ; isn't it equally important that we support the families of others? If you find yourself uncomfortable or disturbed by children, during worship, you might consider sitting in an area with fewer children.

Hospitality is not a given among Christians, it's a "calling" which requires a specific skill set.
