Pastor's Point

I had two big concerns about Joy Church when I came. The First was stewardship – or more to the point – the lack of it. The second, and perhaps more concerning, was that Joy had stopped growing. In fact, it was kind of shrinking in membership and attendance.

If you've been looking at the weekly bulletin and the stewardship picture at Joy, you will see that we've gone a long way to addressing the giving concern that I (and perhaps others) had. Nice going! Good stewardship is a sign of spiritual strength.

When I get back from vacation, I will be putting together another new member class at Joy. It will be my third in the 18 months I've been at Joy. If everyone joins who I've talked to, it will total about 35 new folks at Joy since I've arrived. Again, nice going! Joy is the kind of church with the kind of people who are able to grow. And it's important! Listen to this story.

A "head-hunter" or person who goes out and hires corporation executives for other firms, once told a pastor, "When I get an executive that I'm trying to hire for someone else, I like to disarm him. I offer him a drink, take my coat off, then my vest, undo my tie, throw up my feet and talk about baseball, football, family, whatever, until he's all relaxed. Then, when I think I've got him relaxed, I lean over, look him square in the eye and say, "What's your purpose in life? It's amazing how top executives fall apart at that question.

"Well, I was interviewing this fellow the other day, had him all disarmed, with my feet up on his desk, talking about football. Then I leaned up and said, 'What's your purpose in life, Bob?' And he said, without blinking an eye, 'To go to heaven and take as many people with me as I can.' For the first time in my career I was speechless."

Hey, isn't that what we are to be about as the Lord's church? To one day be with the Lord in heaven and take as many people as we can with us? Think about that the next time we have visitors to Joy! I sure do.


