The sole purpose of this meeting will be to vote on the members of Joy's Call Committee. The Church Council, under the direction of the Florida-Bahamas Synod and in compliance with Joy's Constitution, has nominated seven individuals for election. These will make up the six regular members and one alternate member of the Call Committee. Connie Schmucker, Florida Synod Associate in Ministry and Assistant to the Bishop, will be at Joy for the meeting to observe and answer any questions you might have.

For the past two months the Council has been working diligently through the process to form a Call Committee for our pastoral search at Joy. Below, in brief, are the steps we have taken:

1. July 12th - The Church Council met with Connie Schmucker from the Bishop's office and discussed the possibility of forming a Call Committee. The results of that meeting indicated that Joy had successfully completed the initial Transition Checklist and is ready to proceed to the next step of forming a Call Committee.

2. July 19th - The Council met and reviewed the Transition Manual section regarding Call Committee selection and Joy's Constitution. The Council decided to prayerfully consider candidates who would be a good representation of the whole congregation; a balance of newer and long term members, older and younger members and a balance of male and female members. Suggestions would be considered at the next Council meeting on August 16th.

3. August 16th - The Council shared their input on members they felt would be good representatives of our congregation. After nominations and discussion, nine individuals were approved. These members will be called and asked if they would be willing to serve as a member of the Call Committee to complete this important undertaking in the life of Joy Lutheran Church.

4. When the Call Committee of 6 members and one alternate has been identified and approved by the Church Council, a called congregational meeting will be scheduled to vote on the 6 members and alternate for approval.

Some schedule changes are coming up. Here they are from my memory.



Especially in these days, we pray for all workers, that they will always have a worthy job, and for those that are seeking work, that they might find suitable employment.




The men are always looking for an extra hand to help out. So, come out on Friday mornings and they will put you to work. What a great way to Stewardship your Time.


Church Painting


Please contact the church office, if you would like to have a visit from the Pastor, a Stephen Minister, or would like to be listed for prayer support.

If you enjoy the "Coffee Fellowship", <u>consider</u> signing up to host a Sunday. The signup sheet is in the narthex.




