

Ash Wednesday and Mid-Week Lenten Services at Joy

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 1, with a service of the Imposition of Ashes at Joy. This service will be at 7 pm. On the five following Wednesday evenings, we will have a simple soup and sandwich supper together from 6 until 6:30 pm. Following dinner, we will have a brief service of worship using Holden Evening Prayer. The theme for these mid-week services will be Luther's Major Treatises - one each Wednesday evening. The Freedom of a Christian / To the German Nobility / Bondage of the Will / Treatise on Good Works and Babylonian Captivity of the Church. This theme was chosen especially this year as we celebrate the 500th Anniversary of Luther's 95 Thesis and the beginning of the Protestant Reformation.

LENT

Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word *lencten*, which means "spring." The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry.

Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection. In the early church, Lent was a time to prepare new converts for baptism. Today, Christians focus on their relationship with God, often choosing to give up something or to volunteer and give of themselves for others.

Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini-Easter" and the reverent spirit of Lent is tempered with joyful anticipation of the Resurrection.

Pastor's Perspective

The penitential season of Lent will soon be upon us. It begins on Ash Wednesday - March 1. Normally when we think about Lent, there is behind it the idea of sorrow for sin and amendment of life. We look at our lives and the way we are living in comparison to the example of Christ. Generally, there is a pretty wide gap there and so we need to be about making some changes. We call this repentance - or turning from one way of living to another way more pleasing to God.

A Sunday School teacher was once leading her class on the topic of repentance. After much discussion, the class decided that "true repentance" consisted of two parts. One was feeling sorry for what you have done wrong. The other part was a promise to do better in the future. That decided, the teacher went on to say: "I disagree. I've been repenting like that all my life and I don't think it does much good." I think she was saying that the kind of repentance we do in our hearts or minds seem to fail us. You know, the "spirit is willing but the flesh is weak" problem.

When I think of repentance, I consider it in other terms. I think of it in relation to the prodigal son. Repentance, for me, isn't so much as entering upon a guilt trip about your past or present and then promising to do better in the future. For me, like the prodigal son, it's about a change in location. The prodigal got into trouble when he decided to change his location. He abandoned his family, took his inheritance with him and proceeded to waste it. A kind assessment might be that it was movement toward self-actualization, towards independence, of cutting the apron strings - but it was movement without any significance for his life. The prodigal's real move toward wholeness was when he said to himself: "I will get up and go home." His repentance came about when he decided to change his location and go home.

Most of the trouble we cause ourselves in life comes from being in the wrong location by choice! During Lent, we follow Jesus to the cross. It's a time of movement. A time of changing locations. If you are in a place in life that is leading you to trouble, its more than likely a time to leave old locations behind and deciding to go home. Jesus will be waiting for you!
