

Greetings Joy!

I wanted to update you all on some of the issues facing us at Joy and the progress made resolving them.

<u>Call Committee</u>: The Ministry Site Profile has been approved by Council and the Synod and has been presented to the congregation. The MSP can be now posted and a call list generated by the Synod. We are getting interview training in May and hopefully we can start interviewing candidate soon! Great work from the Call Committee and an important step moving forward for Joy.

<u>Roof Repairs</u>: Our roof was damaged by Hurricane Matthew. The insurance company and our adjuster disagree on the extent of the damages. We had a lawyer serve the insurance company with a 60 day resolution notice. The insurance company will now get an adjuster to meet with our adjuster to come up with an agreed to resolution. If that does not happen, a third adjuster, mutually agreed on, will be used to break the impasse.

<u>Parking</u>: The grass parking area between the paved driveway and Jupiter road is getting progressively muddier and muddier each rainy season. We don't want people getting muddy feet or their cars stuck. Due to the very generous giving to date, the council has approved repair of the area. The area will be regraded, the stump removed, concrete fines and sod installed. It should look very nice and natural and be dry for years to come.

<u>Playground</u>: Joy Men's Group is working on a proposal for a new playground. Stay tuned for more details.
