As I write this, the MSP or Ministry Site Profile of Joy Church is done and posted for potential new pastors to review. The MSP is a comprehensive assessment of Joy congregation and what we are looking for in new leadership. The Florida Synod is working to put together a list of candidates to be interviewed based on the MSP. It's an exciting and interesting time!

From my experience, I know that the above "interesting time" can pass quickly or be extended. Either way, I want to emphasize in whatever time I have left at Joy the CORE VALUES we determined back in 2016. They are, in my opinion, good core values and they fit Joy Church as you are today. You would do well to be reminded of them often and use them as you determine future ministry through Joy Lutheran Church.

Our first core value is WORSHIP. It should be. Everything we are at Joy, I believe, begins with the worship of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It is his salvation we have and his example we follow. As has been said: "Worship is at the same time our highest duty and chief privilege." Good worship feeds the soul and energizes the spirit for service. It is important that we all participate in the worship life of Joy Church and that it always be done well.

Another core value is our PROPERTY. We say that our facility is to be maintained and used to fulfill the spiritual needs of the church and community. We've done a lot to the property at Joy since I've been here and even currently we are working on a new playground structure and enhancements to our front parking. (And when we get through contending with our insurance company, there is probably a new roof in our future as well.) Proper maintenance of our property I think shows how we feel about our Lord. Joy's facilities should always be a silent witness to the way we care for the things of the Lord.

And then there is FELLOWSHIP. We say we like to enjoy one another's company. I hope so! The people at Joy are our sisters and brothers in Christ. The more things we do together - like for example the recent Strawberry Festival - the better. I mean, after all - even Jesus gathered around him a circle of friends.

Let me do one more and I'll leave the rest for next time. WELCOMING. We said that everyone has a place at Joy. We do need to remember that the Lord has put his people at Joy for the nourishment of their souls and for service to his church. If a boss treats his employees badly, he is going to be constantly looking for help and the help he gets won't be very good. Those who work for the Lord need to be in a place where they are valued and lifted-up. As St. Paul reminds us in Romans, the contribution of those with differing gifts are all important within the body of Christ.
