
Since the last issue, Joy met and then called a new pastor - The Rev. John David Bryant who comes to Joy from Zion Lutheran Church in Hickory, NC. I believe Pastor Bryant's first call was in Lake City and so he is not unfamiliar with this area. That's a plus. I've heard from other pastors who know John that he is an excellent pastor and my initial impression concurs. I congratulate the Call Committee at Joy for doing an excellent job. I mention specifically our new electronic sign and a new roof - a major portion of which will be paid for by insurance.

It has been a wonderful three years for Teresa and I while we were together at Joy. I've had a great time leading this excellent group of people and I am grateful for the opportunity. We will miss the people at Joy, but will leave with joy in our hearts knowing your future is bright with a new pastor and the Lord's continued blessing.

Ash Wednesday and Mid-Week Lenten Services at Joy

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14, with a service of the Imposition of Ashes at Joy. This service will be at 7 pm. On the five following Wednesday evenings, we will have a simple soup and sandwich supper together from 6 until 6:30 pm. Following dinner, we will have a brief service of worship using Holden Evening Prayer.

LENT

Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word *lencten*, which means "spring." The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry.

Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection. In the early church, Lent was a time to prepare new converts for baptism. Today, Christians focus on their relationship with God, often choosing to give up something or to volunteer and give of themselves for others.

Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini-Easter" and the reverent spirit of Lent is tempered with joyful anticipation of the Resurrection.




