

"He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit, he prunes to make it bear more fruit...abide in me as I abide in you." -- John 15:2, 4a

It has been an interesting sight to watch the progress on the church roof over the past couple weeks. I didn't know what to expect to see (see photo below). From what I understand, it is the first total re-roofing since at least sometime in the 1980's. There are several interesting elements that have come to light. Some of them are elements that had nearly been lost to memory and time. One example of this is the turnbuckles located on the roof that were meant to be

periodically tightened to take up the "give" that develops in a roof over time (for those interested, Judson Drake has insight into how and why our church and parsonage were constructed the way they are). Some elements are being restored such as the drip pans above where the roof meets the main tower to keep most of the water away from the tower itself. Some elements needed a good clearing out, including places where up to five layers of roofing had been layered one on top of another over the years. You can imagine a wall in your home with layers of paint and wallpaper and what happens when one of the underneath layers begins to warp or peel away. Some elements are being repaired, replaced and re-nailed. Some elements are being upgraded including the installation of ice and water shield on the roofs and attic fans to vent out warm air that contributes to a "hot roof" (which both leads to large amounts of ice and shortens the life of the roof). Most of the materials themselves are designed to last 40-50 years or more while the copper should last with regular maintenance over a century. The result is that the church should receive in the long run very good value for its money. The workers have been amazing to watch as they nimbly move from spot to spot with seemingly not a care about the height...something that would surely catch my attention! At any rate, it is taking a lot of foresight, coordination and skill to see this project through.

How about your relationship with God? Has time obscured or hidden some of the best parts of your faith? Are there key elements of your faith that have atrophied or become dormant with disuse or neglect?....time for prayer, perhaps, or regular reading of scripture or spiritual reading....time for worship, time to serve or advocate for others? Are there places where you have accumulated layers of worry, cares, life events or business that have contributed to not seeing God's active role in your life, even to questioning if God still cares about you or your situation? Where could your life use a good housecleaning? I realized two years ago that I had taken on too many commitments in total at all levels of our denomination and have unwound myself from several of those areas that neither played to my strengths nor allowed for the most central ministry that I do. What in your life needs repair, replaced or even thrown out? What in your life needs a long-term investment, even if it costs more in the short-run? In what areas could you use a skilled person with which to talk, assess and help point you in a helpful direction? For spiritual matters, the church—both through myself and resources in the district, conference and beyond—has much to offer. Particular needs may require other skilled persons. Where do you need to prune? What personal spiritual restoration or repair project do you need to undertake? As you consider that project, remember that God is one who takes on many restoration projects (all of us) and has promised to always do so.




