
Quick! What do the following three images have in common?

As you go about your typical day, what reminds you of God's presence in your life? As you drive to work or to your next appointment for the day, what helps you stay connected to your faith? Perhaps the beauty of the world around you helps you see God. Maybe someone's kindness enables you to encounter Christ. You might feel the Holy Spirit when you pray or are at an event at church. I happen to have an office inside our church, right next to the sanctuary. Even then, it is possible to sometimes take for granted what is right in front of me.

ANSWER: they are all images that appear in similar form somewhere in Gray Memorial UMC's stained glass windows (I have a book with nearly every Christian symbol that appears in churches, including GMUMC's windows and paraments, and their scriptural references. Be in touch if you would like to check it out. You can also search these symbols online).

On June 10, I preached about the meaning in the stained glass windows at Gray Memorial. It was interesting to me the number of people who commented about noticing elements of the windows they hadn't noticed before or appreciating the windows in a renewed way even though, in some cases they have been worshiping amongst the windows for a long time. I believe that those who arranged for our windows to be built wanted reminders of several of the critical elements of our faith in Jesus Christ and how we can illumine these same qualities in others. Sometimes in our journey of faith, we miss the clear signs of Christ's presence among us even though they have always been there. It isn't that God went away or even that we are bad people. We get distracted. Scenes become too familiar. We are busy. Faith is compartmentalized. So, instead, think about what might happen if you expected to see God everywhere you went in most places you look. Think how that might transform your view of God and of the impact of faith. When I expand how and where I see God in the world, the meaning and impact of our Christian faith grows. My prayer is that in similar ways, your faith will grow, too.


