

## **Scheduling Policy**

I. Each team will be granted the possibility of *ONE (1) BYE WEEK* per session. This non-play date is at the discretion of the team. The specific date must be requested in the "Comments" section during the registration process. If you are a coach of multiple teams that compete on the same day, please specify each team's age group & name so that we can accommodate team schedules for the session.

*PLEASE NOTE:* If your league has a combination of dasher and open field games, we do not guarantee a certain numbers of games to be played on either venue.

- **II. No Show Fee's:** In the event that a team does not show, they will forfeit the game and/or games that were to be played. In addition to receiving a loss, the "no-show" team will be responsible for their ref fee and the fee of the opposing team. If both teams do not show they will still be responsible for their ref fee, and the game will result in a tie (*IT WILL NOT BE RESCHEDUELD OR REFUNDED*).
- III. Cancellations: Any issue with a scheduled game must be brought to the attention of Director of Soccer Operations at least 1 week prior to that game. We do not guarantee that we can change any game once it is published to the schedule. Teams that call in to cancel and/or try to have their game switched after Week 3 WILL HAVE TO FORFEIT if they cannot make their scheduled game time. Once the schedule is set, there will be NO CHANGES unless deemed necessary by the Director of Soccer Operations. Teams that cancel will still be obligated to pay the ref fees for both teams.
- IV. Schedule Rotation: PISA will do its best to rotate times and venues. We cannot promise the perfect rotation for every team and/or division. PISA's games will start as early as 6am on the weekends. It is at our digression to move games as we see fit to ensure early morning games are distributed as evenly as possible. Teams will not get their games changed due to complaints about early morning games. If a team decides not to show, they will be obligated to adhere to the sanctions outlined in Section II.
- V. Weather: PISA *will plan to remain* open during inclement weather. Any cancellations/delays will be posted on the homepage prior to the beginning of matches. If there is not a posting on the website, then the facility will remain open and games will be played. Team cancellations/no-shows due to weather will be deemed a forfeit, and the games will not be rescheduled.
- **VI. Divisions**: PISA has the right to promote/demote teams between different divisions if we deem it necessary based upon skill level & league results.
