



Scheduling Policies

- I. **Requests:** Each team will receive **TWO (2)** schedule requests before the start of the season. We understand that teams may have prior obligations; ***no more*** than 2 schedule requests will be given to any team to keep the integrity of the schedule. There will be **NO BULK** schedule requests (I.e. not being able to play at a certain time every week). The schedule will rotate time and venue the best we can taking into consideration the requests. PLEASE NOTE: If your league has a combination of dasher games (2) and open field (1) games we do not guarantee anymore than a 1/3 of your games to be played on the open field.
- II. **No Show Fee's:** In the event that a team does not show, they will forfeit the game and/or games that were to be played. In addition to receiving a loss, the "no-show" team will be responsible for their ref fee and the fee of the opposing team. If both teams do not show they will still be responsible for their ref fee, and the game will result in a tie (*IT WILL NOT BE RESCHEDULED OR REFUNDED*).
- III. **Cancellations:** Teams that call in to cancel and/or try to have their game switched **after Week 3** (when the schedule is finalized) ***will have to forfeit*** if they cannot make their scheduled game time. Once the schedule is set, there will be **NO CHANGES** unless deemed necessary by the Director of Sports/Operations or the General Manager. Teams that cancel will still be obligated to pay the ref fees for both teams.
- IV. **Schedule Rotation:** PISA will do its best to rotate times and venues. We cannot promise the perfect rotation for every team/division. PISA's games will start as early as 6am on the weekends. Teams ***will not*** get their games changed due to complaints about early morning games. If a team decides not to show, they will be obligated to adhere to the sanctions outlined in Section II.
- V. **Weather:** PISA ***will plan to remain*** open during inclement weather. Any cancellations/delays will be posted on the homepage prior to the beginning of matches. If there is not a posting on the website, then the facility will remain open and games will be played. Team cancellations/no-shows due to weather will be deemed a forfeit, and the games will not be rescheduled.
- VI. **Divisions:** PISA has the right to promote/demote teams between different divisions if we deem it necessary based upon skill level & league results.
