

2. Remember the brown scapular?

Saint Simon Stock, was an Englishman who lived in the 13th century. The Blessed Virgin Mary is traditionally said to have appeared to him in 1251 and given him the Carmelite habit, the Brown Scapular, with a promise that those who die wearing it will be saved. It is the badge of salvation, a shield in time of danger, and a pledge of special peace and protection. The Catholic Church has approved eighteen different kinds of scapulars, of which the best known is the woolen brown scapular that the Virgin Mary bestowed on Simon Stock. His feast day is May 16th.

Wearing the brown scapular should remind us of three things. **First**, the scapular is a uniform or badge by which we profess to whom we belong and serve. **Second**, we need to work toward holiness for Our Lady. **Third**, the scapular is a garment of humility and penance; we should accept all the difficulties in our state of life and all the sufferings Our Lady may want to send us.

3. Thursday at Eucharistic Adoration think of five young families and pray a decade of the rosary for each of them.


