The renewal and awareness of the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

**2.** The moral life of Christians is sustained by the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit – wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. St. Martha is the Patron Saint of cooks and dieticians. Too many times we suffer from the defect Jesus found in St. Martha, she placed too much emphasis on serving him with her hands and feet and not enough emphasis in quiet meditation and prayer. “If you are too busy to pray, you are too busy”.

*Dear St. Martha, teach us to recognize Jesus as the Lord of life and death and to trust that as He raised Lazarus, He will also raise each of us and our loved ones on our last day. Through Christ our Lord. Amen*
