# 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

There's the old joke about the fourth grader who had just memorized the Ten Commandments. He was very proud of his accomplishment since he had studied hard and had managed to recite them all without a single mistake. When his mom came to pick up him and his younger brother from religion class the two were standing together on the curb. The younger brother was shaking and sobbing. When mom enquired what had happened, the younger brother pointed to the older and said that he had been punched by him. The mom turned to the fourth grade boy and asked, "Didn't you just learn the commandments? You got them all correct, but now look what you did to your brother. What does the fifth commandment say?" To which the fourth grader replied, "The fifth commandment is, 'You shall not kill.' And I didn't kill him. I just socked him really good!"

Of course it is precisely this kind of literalism that Jesus expects his followers to leave behind. In the Sermon on the Mount, he is teaching his disciples, those who want to live by his words. Again and again in his discourse, Jesus asks his followers to move to a higher ethic by saying, "You have heard it said? But I say to you?" Each time, Jesus proposes moving beyond the strict limit of the law to a fuller understanding of the concept. And that's where it can get difficult.

The fourth grader's behavior according unacceptable, even the common to understanding of what is required by the fifth commandment. But what is asked of the followers of Jesus is so much more. (Just wait till we get to next week's Gospel!) As Christians, we are asked by Jesus to live beyond the law. We are asked to see the law not as a minimal requirement for what we shouldn't do, but as an invitation to extend the boundaries of what we should.

# HOW CAN WE PROMOTE VOCATIONS AWARENESS AT A LEVEL WHERE INTERACTION BETWEEN LAY PEOPLE AND ORDAINED PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS PRESENTS ITSELF AS A REGULAR AND COMFORTABLE OPPORTUNITY?

At the parish level, of course. Specifically, your parish newsletter or parish bulletin can be an excellent vehicle for promoting vocation awareness. Bulletin articles on vocation awareness serve as an inexpensive and simple way to keep ministry on the minds of parishioners. They also plant seeds for those who might have church vocations. 
