Good to Know:

- Make sure Leigh knows the correct car number for your car so your tech card is correct.
- Car number and dial-in must be clearly written on front and back window.
- Each driver will be given two open time trial tickets for each tech card purchased. You **must** have a ticket to run your time trial during open time runs.
- Everyone will be called for a final time run by card color. Best reaction time in each **class** will be the bye car for first round. (If you are the bye car and double-entered, run your first entry, then come back and wait to run last.)
- Second cone is Finish Line (not scoreboards)
- Buy Backs are at the deck window of the tower.
- Come only when your card color is called, ready to race. If you are not ready to race, two minute counter will start, and you will be disqualified if not ready at that time. Please pull forward in staging lanes to prevent back up in return road.
- Two pit crew members are allowed to go with your car beyond the staging lanes. They must sign the waiver on the tower deck and have a wristband. Pit crew members are allowed in burnout and starting area while your car is in burn out box and racing.
- Please do not disturb personnel in the tower once racing begins. If you have any questions or problems, please find Scott or ask a ground official with a radio to call him for you.
- You are welcome to stay or leave your trailer overnight free of charge.
- Glass bottles are not allowed. Please dispose of your trash in nearby trash can, not on the ground.
- A bye car will be chosen every round based on previous round reaction time. Byes carry over until you use them.
- Once there are no more cars in opposite staging lanes, winner of coin flip gets lane choice.
- Purses will be available **at tower deck window**. Your social security number is required in order to receive cash.
- Please do not exceed 5 mph in the return road.
- No one under the age of 16 is allowed to drive scooters, golf carts, etc. at the track, nor are they allowed in front of the staging lanes.
- Spectator tickets should be turned in at the concession stand or tower window in order to be included in prize drawings.
- If you are entering the Quick 16, please review the yellow Quick 16 information sheet.
