# THEY SAID WE WERE CRAZY

The first 1260-X drew a lot of criticism. Its unique design was for comfort and balance but they said it was "funny looking."

We wanted it lightweight, clean and simple so we eliminated gimmicks and razzle dazzle. But the critics said it needed more knobs and a big meter.

We wanted it to be our top of the line, so we used costly components and we didn't cut corners. But they said it was too expensive.

And we designed deep seeking, VLF-motion circuitry so good that we left out the non-motion circuitry. That's when they said we were crazy.

# THEY WERE WRONG

We introduced the 1260-X anyway and the rest is history. It took a few months to catch on but once word got around, sales skyrocketed. It took us over a year to catch up with orders and, in the meantime, the 1260-X became the most talked about, written about and imitated detector in our 53-year history.

# WHAT'S SO GREAT ABOUT IT?

Pick one up and you'll begin to understand immediately. The padded arm rest and the foam hand grip feel like part of your arm. It weighs in at 4 lbs. and it's balanced to feel like less. Turn it on and it's ready to go. Tuning and "ground adjust" are automatic. It has a tuning control if you want to hear a "threshold" tone but you can leave it off and search silently with no loss in depth. It has a sensitivity control to help in wet sand, mineralized ground or areas of electrical interference. It has two discrimination modes. Set them at different levels of trash rejection and you can switch from one to the other simply by pulling the trigger.

#### SLOW MOTION

The 1260-X is a "motion" detector so you have to keep the search coil moving. But you don't have to "whip" it and you can slow it down enough to pinpoint small deep targets. Slow motion VLF-Discrimination lets you reject small pieces of trash, ignore ground minerals and detect valuable targets all at the same time.

#### THE NAIL TEST

Put two 3-inch nails on the ground 10 inches apart and center a dime between them. Now turn the discrimination all the way up and pass the search coil over all 3 items at a normal speed. Your 1260-X should ignore the nails and sound-off over the dime. Try that with any other motion detector and you may find that the dime is rejected along with the nails.

#### THE DIME TEST

Turn up the discrimination until it rejects an aluminum pull tab. Then bury a dime so deep that the 1260-X just barely picks it up. Now test any other motion detector over that same pull tab and dime. If it rejects the pull tab and detects the dime, you've got a pretty good detector. And if you don't have to whip the search coil, you've got one that measures up to the 1260-X.

# THERE'S MORE

Lots more. A double-locking, noslip, no-wobble shaft. An E.S.I. shielded search coil. Built-in wing feet. An optional home-auto recharge kit which plugs right into the control housing. Optional 3¾" coil. An optional Freq Box which eliminates interference from nearby detectors. And of course the 1260-X has something only Fisher detectors can offer...it's backed by the world's oldest and proudest name in metal detectors.



# X Marks The Spot!

These three members of the Fisher X-Team feature automatic tuning, automatic ground rejection, silent, nothreshold operation and slow motion VLF discrimination.

Treasure hunters are hard to please. The 1260-X was greeted with such enthusiasm, we figured we wouldn't need any other models. But we were wrong. Some said it was just too much detector for a beginner, others said it was too expensive or they wanted a body mount, or so on and so forth. So we took it back to the drawing board and designed three new models based on the same patent pending circuitry.

# 1210-X. High performance, low cost

This is our least expensive X detector but don't let that fool you. It's so simple and it performs so well that it's the first choice of a lot of old timers. All you have to do is turn it on, set the desired level of trash rejection and start searching. One knob, one battery and only 2.8 lbs. Yet it penetrates almost as deep and discriminates just about as well as our top of the line 1260-X. The 1210-X has no battery check, no sensitivity control, no optional recharge kit and no optional coils. But if you can find a detector in this price range that comes even close to matching the performance of the 1210-X, let us know. We haven't found one yet.

# 1220-X. Our most popular detector


Two knobs, one switch and lots of versatility. Push the handle mounted toggle switch to the left for automatic VLF-Discrimination. Move it to center position for all-metal detection and to the right for instant battery check. Leave the sensitivity control at maximum or adjust it for optimum performance in wet sand, mineralized ground or areas of electrical interference. And like all X detectors, you can set the discrimination control at 4 to reject small nails. Set it at 6 and you'll lose some of the good stuff (nickels and small gold rings) but you'll reject pull tabs. Set it at 10 and you'll reject just about all small trash including most tabs, foil and bottle caps. And you'll still detect coins, jewelry and other valuable items. If that's not enough, try the hot little 3¾" search coil in super-trashy areas. You'll find good targets where many other detectors become useless.


# 1220-X PRO. Fast and light

We designed this one especially for the competition hunter, shallow water TH'er or just about anyone looking for quick, effortless treasure hunting. It's just like the 1220-X except the control housing is belt mounted and the handle is "S" shaped with an arm rest. The mode-change switch is on the housing so you can stick the search coil in water up to your shoulder. Also on the housing is another Fisher first: a six-position frequency switch to eliminate interference from nearby detectors.

Like all X models, the 1220-X-PRO is a VLF-motion detector designed to work at fast or slow sweep speeds. Fast enough for competition hunts or slow enough for pinpointing. And the handle assembly is so comfortable and so light (just over 2 lbs.) you can swing it for just about as long as you want to.



# Gold Fever . . .

# There's no cure for it. If you've got it, get one of these professional nugget detectors and do it right!

We call these machines our "ground killers" because they were engineered to penetrate the highly mineralized soil where gold nuggets are found. Extra powerful ground reject circuitry, zero discrimination and tough, no-frills construction. No extra knobs. No gadgets. No meter, no motion, no automatic tuning. But lots of depth and 60 hours of battery life. All three models are proven gold finders but they're also used by relic hunters, beachcombers and professional treasure hunters looking for targets beyond the range of ordinary "discriminating" detectors.

# VLF-660 PRO MOTHER LODE. Body mount

The pro model is our best selling nugget detector and with good reason. Two nylon straps let you hang the control box on your hip, chest or wherever you want. The handle and E.S.I. shielded coil weigh only 2.3 pounds. The fibre glass lower stem is double locking so you can set it and forget it. Controls include a battery check, volume control, super-fine 10 turn tuner, dual knob ground reject and a dual mode sensitivity control. Use the VLF-NORMAL mode for easy operation in highly mineralized soil or VLF-MAX for extreme depth in lightly mineralized soil.

# VLF-660 MOTHER LODE. Handle mount

This one operates just like the PRO and prospectors who use it tell us it's so well balanced that the extra weight on the handle doesn't bother them. Both models feature zero discrimination because treasure hunters know that even the slightest degree of discrimination will tune out small pieces of gold. The operating manual was written by a no-nonsense prospector who found several thousand dollars worth of nuggets while testing a VLF 660 prototype. Optional coils include a 3½" E.S.I. nugget coil and a lightweight 11" deep search coil.

# VLF-441. A legend in its own time

The VLF-441 has been used for years by gold nugget prospectors in Australia and the western United States. It's also famous for finds on black sand beaches. A few of the first beachcombers to use it in Southern California actually painted over the Fisher logo so other, less successful detector users wouldn't know what they were using. It's also been used by police departments for body searches and by public works personnel to locate buried pipes and valve boxes. The VLF-441 is similar in operation to the VLF-660 except it has a

single knob ground reject control, a single mode sensitivity control and no battery check. The coil isn't shielded and it's slightly heavier. A body mount version is available and an 8" E.S.I. shielded coil is optional.

·We recommend the VLF-920 CA\$H FINDER for beginners, backpackers or just about anyone interested in a lightweight, low cost detector. It's super easy to use because it has no discrimination mode. It won't tune out small pieces of trash but it will reject ground minerals and it will find all kinds of metals. And it does it with only two knobs and two cheap batteries.

It's rugged, it's good looking and it's well balanced. Tuning is a snap, pinpointing is quick and the 8" search coil is waterproof. If you want a good basic metal detector and you don't want to spend a lot of money on it, look no further. We designed the VLF-920 for you.






