





Over 700 sailors lost their lives, and their precious cargoes of gold and silver were scattered along the Florida coast."

This year, Ken and crew worked the site where the Santa Cristo de San Roman struck the Florida coast. The San Roman had the second largest payload of the fleet - 2,687,416 pesos in gold and silver coins.



White's divers Randy Smith and Jim Jewel recovered 2 Gold Escudos in perfect condition, dated 1715- along with several silver coins, pieces of pottery, and other coral-encrusted objects.

Recently, Ken spent two weeks in a remote area of Russia detecting in cooperation with local archaeologists.

The White's expedition uncovered many coins and artifacts dating to the 12th and 13th Century, and a Mongolian idol dated Before Christ.

Ken White's adventures may take him around the worldsearching for and finding the treasures of yesterday.

Steve Kelly is a born-andbred Irish New Yorker. He knows the city inside and out.

As an employee of the New York Transit Authority, it's his job to know the city. That's

why metal detecting is a natural for Steve. He started detecting five years ago, finding coins and an occasional piece of jewelry. Steve's breakthrough in detecting came when he decided to buy a White's top-of-the-line digital, ground tracking detector. On his way home from Rubenstein's Coin Store, a New York White's dealer, he stopped to try his new detector at a park he had hunted many times before. Three hours later he had 72 coins. "I realized that I


had never known how to ground balance my other detector properly, and was now getting another six inches in depth," says Steve.

Using the motto, "Don't look at the area as it is now, think 'what was it like 20-30 years ago", he began to hunt areas again. Now, he was digging more silver than clad



money. He found a silver skull ring, a gold bracelet and a perfect 1903 Barber Dime.

One day while hunting a heavily wooded area, Steve got a readout of 'quarter at 8 1/2 inches'. Sure he had a silver quarter, he began digging through a web of vines beneath the topsoil. He kept at it, passing handfuls of dirt in front of the

He took the "coin", cleaned it as best he could, and saw what he believed was a medal. Round like a coin, it had a profile of a man on one side, and a man sitting in a chair on the other with some unfamiliar symbols.

Checking to make sure there was nothing else in the hole, he passed another handful of dirt in front of the loop and got another loud beep. This time he had a coin with a Roman figure on it. When he finished, he had six mystery coins in hand.

Ready to do cartwheels at his finds, Steve held his excitement. He decided to find out what the coins were, and if they were authentic.

He took the coins to Rubenstein's where Mel examined them. With a grin, Mel said, "They're real." Further research dated the coins 300 to 250 B.C., minted in Egypt.

How did these coins end up buried in a New York City park? Steve has his own theory, "I feel that someone buried them for safekeeping and ei-

ther forgot about them or passed away before telling anyone of their existence".

6000/Di PRO SL AND ANDY ANDERSEN

Retirement just didn't suit
Andy Andersen. He retired
from the Navy only to
spend 18 years with the
U.S. Postal Service. He
retired from the post
office and fished, played
golf, and metal detected.
Soon after that, he found he
wasn't suited for a life of
leisure.

Now, at 72, he works five days a week selling White's detectors and spends his free time using them to find treasures.

His love for detectors dates to the '60's - his first White's detector was a 4 DB. Though he freely admits, "I've tried them all", he's always come back to White's. "They have always just done the best for me," says Andy.

Andy's home in Cullpepper, Virginia is steeped with history dating back to the 1700's. George Washington laid out the original townsite. It was the site of both Revolutionary and Civil War activity. On the hill overlooking his home, Andy located a Civil War



Connecticut camp site. He found 35 - 40 Civil War buttons at the site, along with some buttons from the Revolutionary War.

His bullet collection, made up entirely of detected finds, is one of the best in the country. Andy has over 300 different types of bullets - including a Shaler sec-

tional, and a Gardiner explosive bullet.

He considers his best find a 1760 coin that remains unidentifiable - even by the experts. He also has one of the "original American silver dollars", an 1808 Mexican Piece of

Eight in excellent condition.

Homesteads are currently Andy's favorite spots to hunt. (The house in the photo at left was built in 1799.)

Many times they have never been hunted, and can be the source of some nice old coins. Wooded areas, long a favorite of relic hunters are "hunted out", Andy says. He prefers farm fields, but quickly adds, "The most important thing is to get the owner's permission."

As for hunting buddies, "Yes, I have a buddy I hunt with quite often," Andy says, adding with a grin, "In fact, I sold him his detector. A White's 6000."



These guys measure their success not in ounces - but pounds. Harvey and Jim W. each have over 6 pounds of gold to their credit. Jim still has every nugget he has ever found. (Stored safely away in the local branch of Fort Knox!)

Finding gold takes work, even for these seasoned veterans. They research

abandoned mining claims in state records for possibilities.

Jim B. explains, "If the gold was extracted hydraulically, there may still be gold there."

An old claim with promise leads to a day of exploration by their loosely-knit group of nine. The group is held together by the spirit of friendly competition, but there's no room for greed or mis-

trust. "We've had to boot a few", says Jim. If no gold is found the first day, they'll usually move on. If it produces gold, they will work it thoroughly.

Frequently the guys are asked about rattlesnakes. Yes, snakes are plentiful in gold country, but no one has been bitten. They attribute not just their gold, but their lucky encounters with slithering creatures to the same thing. Harvey and Jim Williams both swear that the frequency of the Goldmaster alerts snakes. "They won't strike the loop", Harvey explains.

His oldest coin is a very rare 1818 half dollar. This year, he found an 1853 half dime.



He and his hunting partners know the beaches and the ocean like the backs of their hands. They compare notes about conditions on different beaches up and down Southern California's coast. They track swells, winds, and tides.

He describes one of his hunting partners, Richard Losey, as "up and coming"- a very good water

hunter. "He's a young guy but he's getting experienced enough to give me a run for the money," says Lance.

Working the wet sand following storms has proven very productive. After a hurricane hit the California coast last summer, Lance hit paydirt at the beach. He explains, "The weekend after the hurricane, I found 18 pieces of gold - including 14 gold rings, and \$137.00 in coins".

Some of his more unusual finds include a gun that was linked to a murder, a pair of antique handcuffs, and a partial bridge complete with teeth - one bejeweled with a stainless star. The shipwrecks of the late 1800's through the 1920's off Santa Monica Bay have yielded some nice "old gold".

Even though Lances wife, Carol, doesn't hunt with him, neither does she mind the time he spends at the beach. She's the lucky recipient of some of his choicest finds including a 1 1/2 Ct. marquise-cut diamond ring, and a 53-diamond pave ring! The Surf PI combines

CLASSIC III AND SHAWN & SCOTT GRAHAM

The "Graham Treasure
Team" was formed upon the
arrival of their new Classic in the
spring of 1992. Now
armed with their first
detector, they were ready
to "follow the trail to
treasure".

With their new hobby, history has been placed in their hands. Searching at his schoolyard, Shawn found a
Woman's Relief Corps. medal
dated 1883. The story of this
find led to his selection as an
Editor's Choice Award in
Western & Eastern Treasures
magazine's 1992 10 Best Find's
Contest. A pretty hefty honor
for a 10 year old!

Younger brother Scott, 8, unearthed an 1830 U.S. Large Cent in a yard. This coin predates the founding of their lowa town by eight years. The big penny was buried just ten feet from a religious medal of sterling silver, also dated 1830. Coincidence? Maybe.

The kid's own backyard gave up an 1885 Liberty "V" nickel. (Check *tbat* in your coin books!) Three other

\$299.95 sugg. ret. Liberty nickels have surfaced in other area searches. Four different types of silver dimes have presented themselves to these young detectorists; an 1853 Liberty Seated, 1916 Barber, 1942 Mercury, and a 1947-D Roosevelt.

Last summer, they uncovered a U.S. Three Cent piece (no date), and added seven Indian Head pennies to their collection.

The oldest was dated 1881.

They also have an evergrowing can of modern coins, and have recovered rings, a nice bracelet, pocket watch, spoons ...

You might notice in the photo at left that Shawn and Scott both have

headphones attached to their detector. "Taking turns and waiting gets tiresome for kids. The "Y" jack allows them to hunt together and each hear what is going on," explains their father, Bert Graham.

With the guidance of their dad, Shawn and Scott are proof positive that metal detecting is a hobby for the young and the young-at-heart. And there's no need to travel to exotic places to find treasure. It's as close as your own backyard!

Dear Mr. Kenneth White:

We, the archaeologists of Saratov City, were delighted to host you and your group in Saratov, one of the oldest cities in Russia.

We were happy that you demonstrated your metal detectors, which are categorized as the latest state-of-the-art technology and useful in the sphere of archaeology exploration. We are extremely impressed by the ability of your detectors to locate at a certain depth and also discriminate iron, silver or gold, etc.

We appreciate the effort of Global Research and Discovery Network in promoting the exploration of monuments in the area of Saratov.

We would like to acknowledge that during your 8-day exploration with the help of metal detectors you made an important scientific discovery.
