What then shall I do this Lent? Shall I attend an extra Mass? Or may be a bible study class? No, says the Lord, These too are not enough.


Oh, Lord, what shall I do this Lent? Shall I endeavor to pray more? Or visit the sick or poor? No, says the Lord, These are still not enough.
