Policy – Fundraising

Preamble

The Carberry Minor Hockey Association (CMHA) undertakes several fundraisers annually. CMHA canvasses the community for these events and appreciates their contributions.

Policy

CMHA teams shall not undertake any fundraising efforts without the sanction of the CMHA executive board.

Fundraising Conditions

Teams wishing to conduct fundraising activities shall make application to CMHA Executive Board via “Fundraising Application Form”

Application forms can be acquired through the Carberry Minor Hockey Web Site, <http://carberryminorhockey.com/index.html>

All individual team fundraisers will only raise funds for actual costs related to supporting hockey activities, i.e. **Off set costs for tournaments, addition ice rental, others ?**

All fundraising initiatives shall raise only those funds required to support those direct costs for the hockey activities identified within the application.

Fundraising committees shall not canvass local businesses for donations. These fundraising initiatives are not considered part of CMHA fundraising activities and events. No independent team fundraising initiative shall detract, compromise or jeopardize CMHA Fundraisers which are for the benefit the greater hockey community.

All CMHA teams can retain all profits from the 50/50 draws that they hold in their games and/or tournaments. (Exception – 50/50 raffles held at the tournament of champions and any provincial tournaments.) One roll of tickets will be purchased by CMHA for each team per year. The float is the responsibility of the team.

All CMHA fundraising initiatives benefits all players and therefore all families are expected to participate in these efforts.

Fundraising committees must ensure that they abide by these conditions. CMHA Exec will monitor fundraising activities and events on a regular basis and if a fundraising committee is found in breach of this policy then all fundraising initiatives will be ceased immediately for that committee and they may be precluded from holding a fundraising activity or event for the next hockey season.
