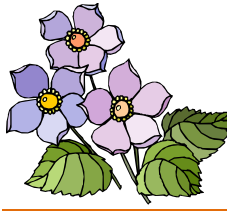

Members generously donated: Paper napkins, washcloths, toothpaste, bar soap, deoderant, toothbrushes, dental floss, toothbrush/cup sets, shaving cream, Wet Ones, shavers, large and small paper plates, plasticware, styro plates, goldfish crackers, miscellaneous toiletries, paper bowls, hair spray, shampoo, gels, drink boxes, hand soap dispensers, paper and plastic cups, peanut butter crackers, granola bars and coffee. And many of those items in large quantities! And with the money some members donated, as well as the balance in our Philanthropy budget, I purchased 5 - \$20 Target Gift Cards, disinfectant wipes, individual containers of Coffee Mate, mac and cheese cups, applesauce, fruit cups, Cheese Its, raisins, cheese and cracker packages, sweetener, Rice Krispie treats, cups of noodles, chips, Combos, as well as more hand sanitizer and tampons. All items they were in need of. I was given a tour of the new Children's Center and it is a wonderful building with various rooms filled with toys, books and other items for the different age groups of children that, unfortunately, need this facility. They are still in the process of some remodeling to accommodate children with disabilities or wheel chairs. There is a part time medical staff to do assessments

of children, in addition to a wonderful staff of people who do challenging work to help children and families in crisis. There were some decorations in some of the rooms that, I was told, are updated monthly by some other Women's Clubs of Medina. As they say...."It takes a Village", and we are part of that Village!
