

Northeast Music News and Notes: May 2019

Northeast Musicians are filling the air with Spring Concert songs, Puppet Opera compositions, and lots of ukulele tunes! It is a busy and fun time for all!

Northeast Fifth Grade musicians have the opportunity to fine-tune their Ukulele skills by joining Uke Club. This group meets from 7:40--8:10AM, in the Northeast Music room, once weekly (on the day when the homeroom group has Music class). We're looking forward to some lively music making!

As Fourth Graders work on their Science case study, students will complete an analysis of Schubert's composition, "The Trout". This includes melodic and rhythmic mapping, identifying & graphing orchestration, and discussion of the setting for the piece, as well as how the melodic line 'represents', in musical form, the lively movements of the fish.

Also, Northeast Fourth Grade musicians are learning to play as an ensemble, with students choosing to work on electric bass, drum kit, ukulele or keyboards. This has been an exciting way to culminate our learning for the year!

Northeast music students in Kindergarten through Grade Three are rehearsing their Puppet Opera performances and polishing their original Puppet Opera Preludes. Our Puppet Operas are based on folk and fairy tales, with music & sound effects created by each music class. It's a great way to learn about Music composition! Our special thanks go to Ms. O'Connor-Ballantyne, a composer from Ithaca College. for working with some of our Second Grade composers to create their original compositions.
