Greetings, Northeast Families -

We are off and running with another terrific school year! These first few days, students have been "learning the ropes": routines, expectations, and even a few glimpses into the exciting curricular offerings for the year. Students in 4th

grade are beginning to design roller coasters as part of their science curriculum. Our 5th graders are starting to collaboratively define what makes good research good, as they self-select fascinating research topics. Third grade students are jumping into deep exploration of character traits including kindness, honesty



and more. Every student in our school and throughout all 8 elementary schools will be sure to have at least one learning experience that's built on the case study model. Students will be engaged in collaborative research and class work that mirrors that of real scientists and historians, as they engage in fieldwork, connect with local/global experts, self-assess, and create high quality products/ projects to share with a real audience. Many of these will culminate in celebrations of learning, so be on the lookout for information about these. Engaging students in meaningful learning experiences is at the heart of what we do, and we're looking forward to sharing this student learning and student voices with you throughout the year.

Chess? Hip-Hop? Knitting? Chemistry?

If your child would like to engage in hands on, after school classes about these topics, then the PTA Enrichment Program is for you! The Northeast PTA offers three sessions of Enrichment each year. Enrichment classes run once a week for 6 weeks from 2:05-3:00 and require parents to register and pay a small fee for each class. Taught by Northeast teachers or community members, these classes offer a way to explore a range of fun and exciting topics in an affordable way.



A few important pieces of information about Enrichment:

- For the fall session, Enrichment is open to students in Grades 1-5. The Kindergarten teachers have asked that K students wait to enroll until further along in the school year.
- Students who participate in Enrichment must be picked up by a caregiver or be enrolled in Kids Count afterschool program. There is no late bus or other transportation for Enrichment students.
- There are scholarships available for students who receive Free or Reduced-Price Lunch. Each child can receive one scholarship per session.
- Families are asked to enroll students in no more than 2 classes each session. If you have more than one child enrolled at Northeast, you can enroll each child in two classes. We ask you to please remember that there are limited spaces available and many students and families interested in Enrichment.
- Enrichment is coordinated by parent volunteers. In years past, there have been issues with families picking up their children late (after 3:00) which is a serious inconvenience to the school staff, the parent volunteers who coordinate Enrichment, and the instructors of the classes. With that in mind, the PTA has instituted a late fee for families who do not pick their children up at the required time. This policy also generates more work for parent volunteers, so please consider carefully if you and your family can meet the expectations for picking



If you have a proposal that needs to be discussed at a PTAB meeting, please send it to the President or Secretary, at least 10 days before our meeting so we can put it on our agenda. The Fall session of Enrichment will open for registration in the next few weeks. We will use an online registration system using Google Forms. Although this new system will continue to have some bumps, we hope that it will address some of the concerns about the timeliness and fairness of registration. If, after learning more about registration, you have any questions or see ways that this won't work for your family, please do contact one of the co-chairs and we will figure out a solution.

Here is an outline of how the system works:


- An email will be sent to all families/caregivers with a link to a description of the classes and registration forms. Families will also be sent home a paper description of classes and the registration process (although there will be no paper registration). If, by September 22, you have not received an email from the list serve or a paper flyer about Enrichment, please contact me and I will send you information directly.
- Online registration will open on 9/25 and close on 10/2 (or when classes are filled if before 10/2).
- Classes will be filled on a first come basis using the online form.
- Once a spot in an Enrichment class is filled, families/caregivers will be notified and will have 3 school days to return a signed permission form and payment for the class in order to preserve the place.
- If the payment/form is not returned on time, spots will be filled from the wait list. Checks must be made payable to Northeast PTA in order to be processed.

Registrations will be processed and classes will be confirmed from 10/2-10/13 and classes will begin on October 16. Enrichment classes are a great way for your child to enjoy some low-cost, exciting activities after school. If you have any

suggestions for ways to improve the Enrichment program, ideas for classes, or want

to volunteer, please get in touch!

News from the Health Office

Hope everyone had a great summer and are happy to be back at school!

There have been some changes in the New York State immunization requirements for school attendance this year. For a complete listing, please go to the Ithaca City School District website and if you have any questions, I will be happy to help you. As I review immunizations for new entrants and by grade level, if your student is missing any immunizations, I will be contacting you.

Also, when your child has a physical exam, please ask the doctor's office to fax a copy to the school nurse. 607-257-8157

If your child needs medication at school, we must have a doctor's order, parent permission and the parent must provide the medication in the original container for use at school.

Just a reminder, during the school day, sometimes the students need a change of clothing. Most students prefer their own clothing rather than "borrowing" clothes from the health office. Please send a change of clothing for your child that can be kept in the classroom. Also, on PE days, the students need socks and sneakers. They can keep an extra pair of socks at school too. If anyone has gently used sneakers to donate to the PE teachers, they

can let students use them when students forget their sneakers.

I would also like to have a few donations of clothing to the health office to lend out. Especially larger size elastic waist pants and t-shirts.

Although the weather is nice now, the cold weather will be here before we know it! We can always use donations of boots, warm winter jackets, snow pants, gloves, mittens and NEW hats. These items are kept in the Borrowing Closet for students use.
