A New Volunteer Opportunity...

Did you know? ICSD policy requires school recess to be held indoors if either the wind-chill or absolute temperature is 10 degrees or below.

In an effort to help facilitate an engaging and fun recess period on indoor recess days, Principal Coyle and school staff have created a cart full of games and activities that can help to supplement the indoor recess time for students. Great idea, right?



How can you HELP? We are looking for parents or caregivers that are available to volunteer at the school from 10:30 AM-12:30 PM any day that school is in session. On indoor recess days, the volunteer would take the game and activity cart to each classroom at the scheduled times. On days that recess is outdoors, there are many other ways to help the school community. Some additional tasks that you may be asked to help with are:

- Make copies for teachers/main office.
- Laminate and or cut out teacher materials.
- Help in the library.
- Deliver materials to classrooms if needed.
- Additional tasks as needed by office or staff.
- What is the time commitment? It is just 2 hours/day on the day(s) that you volunteer. Volunteer once, volunteer once/week, whatever you can do.

What skills are needed? There are no specific skills that are needed. You will not be working directly with students during your shift..Just sign in at the main office when you arrive and Tami or Cindy can let you know where you are needed.



From The Health Office

The school year is half over and as we look toward Spring, I have a few reminders for parents:

The weather is cold and snowy now, please be sure the children have their coat, snow pants, boots, hats and gloves or mittens, We do go outside for recess everyday unless the temperature is deemed too cold or it is raining. The borrowing closet has cold weather items for children to use if needed. If you have any cold weather clothing that you wish to donate, please bring them to Nurse Cindy or the Family Liaison, Mackenzie Torelli.

MEDICINE For healthy rea

If your child needs any medication at school, we must have a doctor's order and the parent/guardian must bring

the medication to school to give to the nurse This includes prescription medications as well as over-the-counter medications.

The PE teachers no longer keep borrowing sneakers for students. There are some sneakers in the borrowing closet, but please make sure your child has their

sneakers and socks on PE days. This is important when the weather gets nice and they wear sandals

to school on a PE day and then need socks. A spare pair of socks can be left in your child's backpack.


Head lice can occur anytime, so I urge parents/guardians to check your child's head at least once a week very carefully. Remind children not to share hats, brushes or combs with others.

If your child has a bathroom accident at school, we do have some clothing to lend, but most children prefer their own clothing. You may want to send a change of clothing to school that can be left at school in case they need it.

If your child has a physical exam, please remind the doctor's office to FAX it to school at 607-257-8157. If your child is injured or has a cast or needs any other restrictions from PE/sports/recess, we must have a doctor's note to excuse them. A parent note can only excuse a student for up to two days. The same goes for keeping a child indoors for recess. We must have a doctor's note.

Dropping Off and Picking Up

Please do not park in the first driveway, pull ahead into a parking space if you need to come in the building. Also, please do not allow your child to exit your car from the left lane of the traffic loop. And remember, no cars allowed in the bus lane during school hours!



Two-Hour Delay Procedure:

On these days, parents are encouraged to develop a plan so their children can safely stay home for an additional two hours.

In the event that a two-hour delay is activated, the following procedures will be followed:

- 1. Local news and radio stations will be contacted to report the delayed start, notices will be posted on the District website, Twitter and Facebook pages and emails will be sent to families using the SchoolMessenger system. Caregivers are encouraged to update their contact information in SchoolTool by contacting their school secretary.
- 2. If conditions do not improve within two hours, classes may be cancelled for the entire day and the same methods of notification will be made.
- 3. All bus routes will be delayed by exactly two hours (i.e. If your bus stop is normally at 8:37 a.m., it will be at 10:37 a.m. on delayed start days).
- 4. All schools will start exactly two hours later than normal. Elementary students should arrive at school between 9:40 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
- 5. Secondary school doors will open at 10:30 a.m. Students will follow a condensed bell schedule of all scheduled classes. There will be no zero period at Ithaca High School on two-hour delay days.
- 6. Pre-K classes will NOT be held if a two-hour delay occurs on a Friday. This does not apply to Pre-K 12:45 dismissal classes.
- 7. Simple breakfasts will be available to students when schools open and regular lunches will be served at modified times.
- 8. Schools will be dismissed at their normal times at the end of the school day.
