Route Repair Update:

- Routes done recently: CSP: replaced bolts on backside of Harbinger on paydirt pinnacle; Rushmore: Top 2 bolts on Mr Critical, Replaced the anchor on Yuppie Warfare, Serial Killer has new anchor and bolts, Plan Is to do Hardrocker on Sat afternoon, plan to replace lower 3 bolts and recon the upper bolt because you can place gear also close to the top bolt,
- Hardware is on backorder from FIXE but should have in Aug. Plan to powder coat in Aug if anyone is interested in helping out. Plan to propose to Rich for powder coating nuts on an all threaded rod and not powder coating the bolt heads that usually get scuffed anyway and this is very time consuming.
- Rich came up with a bolting template that is working very well. He stamped out a hanger outline that is helping to do a better repair. Thanks!
- Access fund is impressed with our bolting procedures, Ron plans to attend Bolting meeting in vegas for the access fund on Nov 15 and 16th. Can discuss our procedures and how we communicate with 3 different land manager groups.
- Pin Fest: This Sat! Ron and Jason to bring ropes, Jason to bring T-shirts and h20. Will start to run ropes through the anchors at 2pm to easy take down.
- No update from CSP about trail work but it is still in the works.
- T-shirts are now at Granite Sports: We paid 8 per shirt, Granite paid 16 and is selling them for 25. Also Granite Sports said we can have a donation box there. Adam Bergdale to work on this.
