- Mt Rushmore and the EA (Environmental Assessment) and trails project: Bruce Weisman from Rushmore Memorial Park, wants to GPS map the trails, Mark Jobman and Jason McNabb to map GPS sites for them. Weisman has 138,000 to spend on the trails project but has a deadline, so we may work together to provide a fund that will keep the funds until they are needed. This will be set up with the Access Fund and will help us with managing the funds. These funds will be to put up speed limit signs, trails and service signage. Bruce will be speaking with the access fund tomorrow. Bruce Weisman would like the BHCC to help with the Rushmore Climbing Management Plan. This is excellent, we are setting the stage locally for national recognition and paving the way for others how to work with the land managers.
