UE Sideliners Calendar of Events	The UE Sideliners Calendar was distributed to the group and discussed.	
Priorities/Expenses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club shirts for modified and JV players. They are just tee shirts that were handed out to the kids. Usually get about 100. We got them last year from NuWaka. They were \$5 per shirt and they did not charge by the letter. NuWaka has last year's order on file for the purpose of sizing. Note: They always ran out of smalls last year. There is a 2 week turnaround on the shirts. • Game Day Shirts for the Varsity Boys and Girls. We budgeted \$500 for this last year. Coaches pick this out wherever they want to. Coaches do the work and send us a bill. There are at least 20 kids per team. Coach and assistant coach also get these shirts. We are not responsible for more than \$500 if they go over the coaches are responsible for the difference. Send the 	

	<p>coaches an email to remember the game day shirts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Homecoming Picnic: This is after the homecoming parade. We provided pizza and water for the soccer players at the club house. Email would go to parents to provide treats. Alicia asked if we ever had each team provide each item. Example Modified Boys are in charge of pizza. Budget was \$300. Issue: Soccer is towards the end of the parade so other sports want to participate. Alicia asked if there is somewhere else we can do it. We do under the club house in case it rains. We are the only booster club that does anything at the homecoming parade. Homecoming is the first Saturday of October (October 1st). • Meals for Away Games: Money is allotted for away games. We used to do this for JV and Varsity when they travelled together. Horseheads, Corning, Ithaca, and Elmira are what other sports do for food, not all away games. Team parents can also organize parents on the team to provide food/snacks for the different trips. The budget was \$100 for each team (Only JV and Varsity Boys and Girls)(Total \$400 budgeted). Alecia feels we should not pay for snakes b/c membership to the booster club is not mandatory. • Black and Orange Night: Modified party we do in place of the banquet that occurs after the under the lights game at the varsity field. We provide pizza, water, coffee, cake, decorations and paper products were provided. There are decorations left over from last year. Budget was \$200 total for both boys and girls. Player parents did a dish to pass. Note: We need to contact Josh Gannon to reserve upstairs cafeteria. • Senior Night: It is for senior girls and boys. We allotted \$400 per team (boys and girls). (\$200 for boys and \$200 for girls team). We also a lot another \$100 additional for flowers. We provided Pizza, Cake, Water, balloons, and paper products. Players parents bring a dish to pass. Team parents are responsible for senior gifts in the past. • Website (UE Soccer): Website fee \$86, Website domain name fee \$30. Website fee expires August of 2016 so we need to get on this. Treasurer was given the information on how to do this from the previous treasurer. • PO BOX Fee: \$130 annually. The box exists at the Endicott post office. No booster club has their mailbox at the main office. • Player assisted fund: This is a fund for those that 	
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	<p>cannot afford equipment needed like cleats. This is at the discretion of the coach. We budget \$100 for this.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bank Fees: \$25 for overdrafts etc. • Booster Club Insurance: \$300 (We have to have this). This is due in September. • Banquet Fees: \$18 per person. We pay for the players, the coaches, their spouses, and facilitators which includes of board of education. • Scholarships: All seniors have the ability to apply for a scholarship. 	
Finances	As of current after all checks have cleared the club has \$6000.	
Memberships	The UE Booster Club Membership form was distributed. Discussion ensued as to whether or not this should be mandatory or not. Who will enforce it if we do make it mandatory. We will need volunteers to go to each team meeting to talk about team parents, get information such as emails and contact information, and talk about the membership and what the money is used for.
