## RIVERWIND HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION INC. RULES AND REGULATIONS POOL and HOT TUB (SPA)

The pool is open for residents and their guests from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests and shall be with them at all times.

## NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY

A first aid kit is located in the Clubhouse.

An emergency phone is located in the Clubhouse in addition to the one outside

- 1. Take a shower before entering the pool or hot tub. Soap is not permitted in the pool shower.
- 2. Shower if leaving the pool to enter the hot tub. The chemicals in the pool are not the same as in hot tub and will degrade the hot tub solution causing it to be closed.
- 3. Do not wear jewelry of any kind in the pool or hot tub as the chemicals can react to some metals.
- 4. The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool at any one time is 15 (fifteen).
- 5. Children age 16 (sixteen) and under may use the pool only under adult supervision from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., and from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
  - a. Children wearing diapers and/or rubber pants are not permitted in the pool.
  - b. Children under 12 (twelve) are not allowed in hot tub area.
- 6. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Residents and/or the RHOA are not responsible for any accident, injury, loss or liability in the pool or hot tub area.
- 7. Running, boisterous or rough play, ball playing, Frisbees, diving or jumping into the pool are prohibited. No toys, floating objects, snorkels, fins or floating mattresses are permitted. Swim aids that are designed to aid in swimming or water safety are permitted.
  - 8. Adults should not swim alone.
  - 9. Radios, tape and CD players are not permitted except when used with earphones.
  - 10. Smoking in the pool and hot tub is prohibited.
  - 11. No glassware or glass bottles are allowed in the pool area.
- 12. Residents and guests must clean up after themselves. Cigarette butts and all trash must be deposited in the receptacles provided.
  - 13. No person under the influence of drugs or alcohol may use the pool or hot tub.
  - 14. Pets are prohibited in the pool, hot tub and adjacent area.
  - 15. No one with skin, eye, ear, nasal infection, communicable disease or illness may use the pool or hot tub.
- 16. Restroom access is restricted to the single door of the Main Clubhouse adjacent to the pool, not the Main Clubhouse door. Residents must unlock this door before using the pool/hot tub. Residents must relock adjacent Clubhouse door upon leaving pool/hot tub area.
  - 17. In the event of lightning, thunder or rain Everyone MUST EXIT the pool and/or hot tub immediately.
  - 18. Everyone must exit the pool and hot tub when maintenance is needed.

The RHOA reserves the right to deny use of the pool, hot tub and adjacent area to anyone at any time, and to close the pool/hot tub without notice.
