For the last half of term we will be looking at 'Growing', the children have grown lots of plants from seed and they have now been transferred into our garden, and 'Moving On'. Now we've started using our mud kitchen a bit more please be aware that their clothes may get a bit dirty, therefore we would ask that they come to school with plenty of spare clothes including pants and socks!



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As the weather warms up we would like to remind you that your child will need sunscreen applied before they arrive at nursery, and if staying all day, they will need their own named sunscreen to be kept in school.

All children will need either a wide brimmed sunhat or legionnaire style peaked cap. If you wish your child to wear sunglasses please can you ensure they are fully UVA/UVB protecting. 'Fashion' sunglasses are not acceptable and please be aware that children wear sunglasses at their own risk.

Appropriate footwear for outdoor play includes trainers, shoes, or strapped or Velcro sandals. Please no 'crocs' - we have had many accidents in the past involving this type of footwear.

A reminder also for all children to have a <u>named</u> water bottle filled with <u>water</u> for the classroom.

Staff will soon be preparing the transition forms for the Giraffes. A copy of this will go to your child's new school after you have read and signed it. Your child's keyworker will let you know when they are ready.
