Directions **Direction from the east:** take #1 the trans Canada hwy east to Dunmore turn left at coop gas station onto Eagle Butte road go south 15 km turn right at 7 metal grain bins (102), then first left (Road 52), first right address on the gate 10112 RR 52.

Directions from the West: take #1 the trans Canada hwy west to Dunmore turn right at coop gas station onto Eagle Butte road go south 15 km turn right at 7 metal grain bins (102), then first left (Road 52), first right address on the gate 10112 RR 52.

Directions from #3: take the #3 to TWP 120 just past Seven Person turn right go 15 km to Eagle Butte road turn right go south 15 km turn right at 7 metal grain bins (102), then first left (Road 52), first right address on the gate 10112 RR 52.
