Entries open May 8, 2017 and will remain open until limits are reached or May 26 @ 11:59pm

Entry limit is 70 runs per trial or 5.5 hours of judging

There will be ribbons for qualifying scores and placements within classes!

A Fun Test is an official, licensed, practice Event for Barn Hunt. No qualifying legs counting toward titles will be earned

Competitors may enter any level they wish and may enter more than one level and/or multiple times in Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior and Master with the same dog. This is a great opportunity to enter all the course levels. It's great experience for you and your dog to try hunting multiple rats on one course. You are allowed training in the ring (without food).

Training must be completed within the time allowed for the class entered. As soon as the Judge confirms training is occurring, the Judge calls TRAINING to the Scribe, who marks an X on the scribe sheet. The Judge will monitor but not aid or assist any training activities other than pointing out a rat location on request.

All other rules pertaining to Licensed Trials also pertain to Fun Tests.

- From Medicine Hat take the Trans Canada highway west to Dunmore turn right at coop gas station onto Eagle Butte road
- go south 15 km...
- turn right onto (102) at 7 metal grain bins
- take first left (Road 52)
- then your next right Gate # 10112. Drive past the house to the yellow building.
