

#### **TRASH REFRESH**

- Trash & Bulk Pick-Up are every Friday.
- If you have an alley, your trash goes in the black can in the alley. If you do not have an alley, it goes on the street.
- Bulk-up goes on the curb in front of YOUR house and should not be put out earlier than Thursday afternoon.
- Recycling is every other Friday and goes in the blue can on the curb.
- Grass clippings, leaves, & lawn refuse go in clear bags along side your bulk pick up on the front curb. \*This is a change from previous procedure.
