

# **Just a reminder...**

Since fall is upon us and all those leaves will be falling soon, we wanted to remind everyone about the historic district guidelines and also how trash & yard waste collections happen throughout the neighborhood!



Here are a few tips or refreshers that we all need to

Repairs & Modifications: Your home is in the Port Norfolk Historic District, which means any modifications to the exterior of your home must be approved by the Historic Preservation Committee before doing anything. Please contact Portsmouth Planning Manager, at 393-8836 if you have any questions, prior to making changes!

**Trash Pickup:** We are unique in that we have alleys, but they can cause confusion when it comes to pickup. The standard black trash bins are collected from the alley every Friday. Bulk trash is collected from the street. Please do not put out bulk trash until Thursday evening for Friday pickup. Remember, lawn clippings and leaves need to be in **clear** plastic bags. Bulk trucks will not pick up on the street, and garbage trucks will not pick up bulk left in the alley!

**Recycling bins:** Recycling bins are to be placed curbside, in front of your house, and will be picked up every other week, on Fridays. Once bins have been emptied, please place them somewhere inconspicuous, such as the side or rear of your house.

**Grass:** Please cut your grass on a regular basis. Otherwise you run the risk of receiving a letter from the City, letting you know that you've been warned once and next time you'll be fined, not to mention you could be the recipient of a very expensive contractor lawn cutting.
