## Road Improvements...

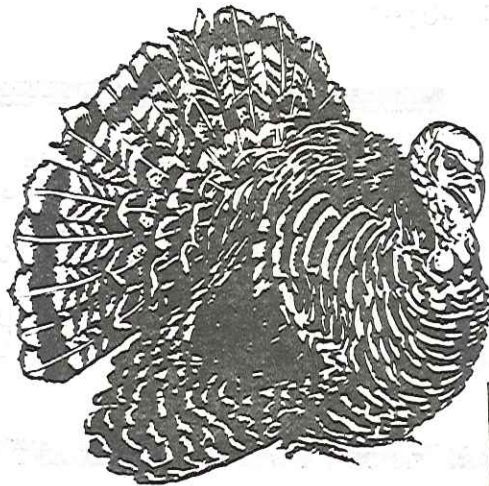
