The Great Race Is Coming To Portsmouth!

On June 24th, Portsmouth will host an overnight stop of the Great Race! The Great Race, the world's premiere old car rally, will bring more than 100 antique automobiles downtown to North Landing for the \$150,000 event. The race will start in Maine on June 21 and weave its way 2,100 miles over nine days down the Atlantic Coast through 13 states before the finish in Florida, on June 29. The cars will arrive in Portsmouth after 5:30p.m. at one-minute intervals for more than an hour and a half and stay parked for several hours to allow spectators to visit with the participants and to look at the cars. The City of Portsmouth is hosting the stop locally with great food, live entertainment, kids events and great food sponsored by Shakey's who is the Portsmouth business sponsoring the meal for the participants. A Little History Lesson about Historical Port Norfolk!

Port Norfolk is one of five Historic Districts in Portsmouth. These neighborhoods were recognized on both the Virginia Landmarks Register and the National Register of Historic Places. A local historic districts Zoning Ordinance was adopted in 1967 and updated in 2007. The Port Norfolk Historic District was established in 1983.

The Zoning Ordinance provides protection for the preservation of the Historic Districts. Section 40.54 of the Zoning Ordinance requires that a building owner receive a Certificate of Appropriateness from the Historic Preservation Commission prior to any exterior alterations being made. All alterations should be in accordance with the design guidelines. The guidelines can be found online or reviewed at the Planning Department office. The Historic Preservation Commission members are citizen volunteers.

Applications should be submitted to the Planning Department, located on the 4th floor of City Hall. The Planning Department can be reached at 757-393-8836. Many applications can be handled administratively over the phone.

Please remember that the HPC is dedicated to preserving the historic character of the city's historic districts. This ultimately protects the quality of your neighborhood and the value of your home!

If you have any question about whether improvements you want to do to the exterior of your home is allowed or not, please call first. You can be subject to fines if you proceed without approval. The people in the planning dept. are knowledgeable as well as helpful and they are happy to help guide you around any pitfalls.

Thank you for preserving your home for future generations to treasure, and helping our neighborhood maintain the unique character that put us on the register of historic places!
