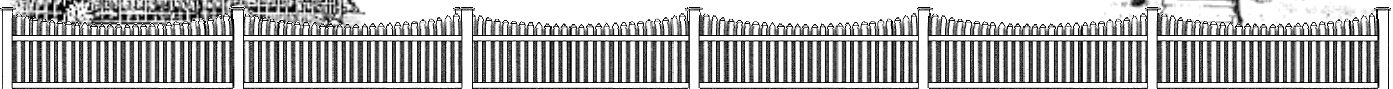

This annual eight-mile parade is regarded as one of the longest parade routes in the nation! The parade will start at 10 a.m. at I.C. Norcom High School, located at 1800 High Street, and continue as follows: down High Street; left onto Frederick Boulevard; left onto Portsmouth Boulevard; left onto Elm Avenue; left on to High Street; and ending at I.C. Norcom High School. The Buffalo Riders, founded in 1997, is an African-American equestrian team that honors the contributions of the Buffalo Soldiers and the Black Cowboys of the Old West.
