Our objective is to introduce the Arabic language throughout the year along with Quranic studies so the students will be able to start recognizing and reading in addition to understanding (level based) some Arabic words and sentences to help them be able to read Arabic fluently, *in-shaa'a-llaah*. At the end of school year students will, *in-shaa'a-llaah*:

Have had mastered the Arabic alphabet and many word and phrases also will be able to distinguish and Pronounce all Arabic sounds, and write accurately from dictation;

Level 1:

Objectives: Students will be able to;:

- Recognize the Arabic letters with their sounds
- Recognize the colors, Shapes and Numbers in Arabic.
- Recognize and understand Level appropriate Arabic vocabularies
- use simple sentences in a conversation
- Sing a song in Arabic

Expectations:

- Students should know and recognize all the Arabic alphabet and their shapes and sounds by the end of the school year
- Students should be able to count to 10 in Arabic
- Students should be able to recognize the basic letters in Arabic
- Students should know at least 20 Arabic words and their meanings
