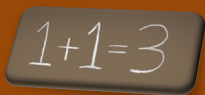

Postage Stamps Needed

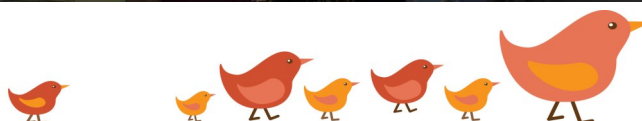

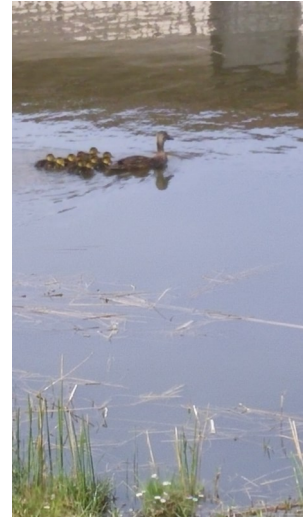
Satellite of Tomoka Christian Church Fact Sheet

- Tomoka Christian Church (TCC) Web Site: <http://www.tomoka.cc/>
- We would sign over all PBCC property to TCC
- TCC assumes PBCC debt - ~ \$975,000
- TCC provides 3 staff positions – full time positions; reside locally
 - Campus Minister
 - Worship Minister
 - Children/Youth Minister
- PBCC leaders would be involved in approval process of staff
- TCC wants the preschool to continue; It is an outreach into the community
- TCC would secure funds for:
 - Outside and Inside Repair of Facility
 - Renovation/Improvements of Facility
 - Additional equipment
- Church Name would change
- ‘Launch date’ for new church is at least 6 months away
- PBCC doors would close approximately 2 weeks prior to ‘launch date’
 - We will still meet to worship those 2 weeks
- Repairs/renovation/improvements to be started prior to ‘launch date’
- Staff would be hired early enough to help plan all details for ‘launch’
- Marketing plan of new church would start well ahead of ‘launch date’
- Sermon would be a video stream of one of their services
- TCC elders are on board with PBCC being the first multi-site church location
- TCC elders will meet Monday night (April 18th) for final decision to proceed
- Many details of this transition process are not known at this time
- A congregational vote by PBCC members is scheduled for May 1, 2016 following the morning service.
 - This vote is to decide if we as a congregation would sign over PBCC property to TCC and begin the process to become a satellite congregation of TCC
- TCC would have a congregational vote to assume the near \$1 million debt for the process to start.

Harvest Helps Lead National Day of Prayer

For decades now, the National Day of Prayer, on the first Thursday of May, has been a very special day for the Church in the United States. There really is nothing quite like it. In 2011 there were more than 40,000 prayer events on that day. Millions of Christians gathered in churches, homes, City Halls, and State Houses to honor the Lord and to seek Him on behalf of the nation.

Like most prayer ministries, Harvest Prayer Ministries whole heartedly encourages Christians to participate and join in one of these observances in their area. But as a ministry we are closely tied to the National Day of Prayer. Our founder, Dave Butts, has served as Chairman of the Board of Directors for the National Day of Prayer Task Force for the past 9 years. Vice Presidents Jon Graf and Kim Butts (also co-founder) serve on the board of directors for the NDOP as well.

On a typical first Thursday in May, you will find Dave on Capitol Hill in Washington DC. Along with NDOP Task Force Chairperson Shirley Dobson and the Honorary Chairman (this year it's Dr. David Jeremiah), Dave helps provide leadership for the very special 3-hour prayer service held in one of the Congressional Office Buildings. Most years, he leads in a prayer time for the Executive Branch of the U.S. Government.

Supporters of Harvest Prayer Ministries have the satisfaction of knowing that they are helping the prayer movement in a very special way through Harvest's involvement in leading prayer on behalf of the nation. We hope this May 5th will find you joining us in prayer for the United States.
