## Community foundations raise \$497,000 in one day!

More than 1,000 Manitobans supported their local communities during the Endow Manitoba 24 Hour Giving Challenge on Saturday, Nov. 19. Gifts totaling more than \$445,000 were stretched by almost \$52,000 in additional support from The Winnipeg Foundation.
