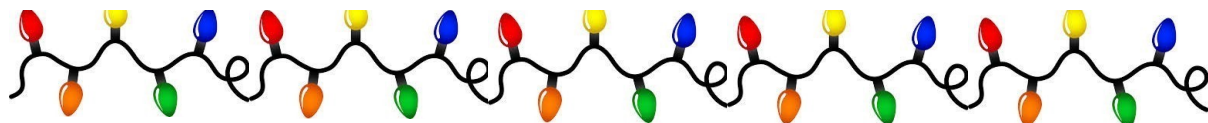
the future. It is very satisfying to see the legacy that is being created.
