Youth in Philanthropy (YiP)

Youth in Philanthropy is a program designed to introduce local high school students to philanthropy and community development. The program provides hands-on experience that b e n e f its b o th th e participating grade 10 Skills class Carberry Collegiate students and local charities.

The 2011-2012 Grade 10 Skills classes "A" and "B" at Carberry Collegiate participated in the 8th annual YiP program. Again, it has proved to be a very successful program with the students, as it educated them about our local community foundation and the needs of our various local non profit organizations. Each class was given \$1,000 plus \$300 of their fundraising dollars to be allocated to an

organization they felt worthy of financial support. Course teacher, Carmen McNabb, oversaw both of the grade 10 classes discussions and debates.

After much discussion and debate, Skills Class "A" decided to grant the Carberry Rec. Centre pool \$550 and \$600 to the Carberry Ag. Society for the repairs to the grandstands.

Skills Class "B" granted \$600 to the Carberry Children's Memorial Park Association to go toward building a SK8 Park, \$550 also to the Carberry Rec. Centre for the soccer club.

Thank you to the YiP students for taking part in this program and helping to make our community a better place.

Recent Donor

The Carberry and Area Community Foundation recently received a substantial donation from Alice Stevens of Carberry, Manitoba.

Alice requested that her donation be put into a new endowment fund created within the CACF called the Edith "Alice" Stevens Fund. Starting in 2013, preference will be given to grant applications which:
