## Youth in Philanthropy (YiP)

Youth in Philanthropy is a program designed to introduce local high school students to philanthropy and community development. The program provides hands-on experience that benefits both the participating grade 10 Skills class Carberry Collegiate students and local charities.

The 2012—2013 Grade 10 Skills classes “A” and “B” at Carberry Collegiate participated in the 9th annual YiP program. Again, it has proved to be a very successful program with the students, as it educated them about our local community foundation and the needs of our various local non profit organizations. Each class was given \$1,000 plus \$300 of their fundraising dollars to be allocated to an

organization they felt worthy of financial support. Course teacher, Carmen Kostenchuk, oversaw both of the grade 10 classes discussions and debates.

After much discussion and debate, Skills Class “A” decided to grant the Carberry Rec. Centre \$575 to help with the cost of new puck boards in the arena and \$575 to CCMPA for ramps and resurfacing of the Faze #1 SK/8 Bike Park.

Skills Class “B” granted \$1,150 to the Carberry Children’s Memorial Park Association to go toward Faze #1 SK/8 Bike Park on a priority needs basis.

Thank you to the YiP students for taking part in this program and helping to make our community a better place.

## Recent Donor and New Fund

The Carberry and Area Community Foundation recently received a special donation from Bernice Lupton of Carberry, Manitoba. With this gift CACF created the *Jack Lupton Memorial Education Assistance Award*.

This memorial award will provide yearly educational assistance in the amount of \$500 to a student graduating at Carberry Collegiate who

wants to pursue further post secondary studies in the fields of journalism and/or sports.

For the past 2 years, Bernice has funded this award through yearly donations and she will again this year. The fund will start earning its own interest for the award in 2014.
