- ~benefit the whole community, encourage more efficient use of community resources.

- ~demonstrate new approaches and techniques in the solution of community problems.

- ~address the underlying causes of problems in our society.

- ~promote cooperation and sharing among organizations.

- ~eliminate duplication of services.

- ~promote volunteer participation and strengthen agencies' management capabilities.

The deadlines for grant applications are: in April and in October of each year. Decisions are made and grant recipients are notified no later than May 31st and Nov 30th.

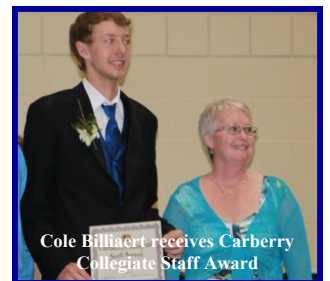
Thomas Bailey receives T. Roy and Edith Bailey Memorial Scholarship
