This book describes a day in the life of Lady, a certified therapy dog, and her owner, Kathy, a nurse. She "works" visiting sick people in a hospital, bringing comfort and cheer to those who enjoy dogs. The training, characteristics, and responsibilities of a therapy dog are explained in language easily understood by beginning readers, and the respect working dogs deserve is emphasized. The message is an important one for children. The content is interesting and educational, and I believe would be entertaining to a young audience. The book would be an ideal gift for a child receiving treatment, or who has a friend or relative receiving treatment, in a hospital where therapy dogs are employed. I would recommend it for children under 7.
