The Fairy Chronicles is a series of books telling about the adventures of four normal schoolgirls who are actually also fairies, each with their own special power. Their fairy names are Marigold, Dragonfly, Thistle, and Firefly. In this particular book, Dragonfly and the Web of Dreams, the girls are living their normal lives, when one day they are suddenly called to a fairy meeting. The important and urgent issue to be discussed there is that many people suddenly start having nightmares, which is very unusual. The reason is that the Web of Dreams was destroyed, but it is not known by whom. Thus, the fairies and their other fairy friends, led by Dragonfly, engage on a daring adventure to find the Dream Spider, in hopes of persuading him to find a solution for the problem. On the way, they are faced with many obstacles that they must overcome in order to accomplish their mission such as inadequate forms of transportation and the presence of trolls. They finally meet the Dream Spider, and after series of incidents, Drommelak, the evil dream spirit, is captured and the Web of Dreams is repaired, removing the people's bad dreams and restoring comfort and peace.

The characters are all very well created and they are each so contrasting, with their vibrant and brave personalities, yet fit together as a group so well.
