The recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) will be notified via scholarship award programs at each high school. Recipients are asked to be available for public recognition of the award prior to the Saturday night rodeo at the Stonewall Peach JAMBoree, June 17, 2017.

Applications must be postmarked by Friday, March 31, 2017.
Applications will not be accepted after Tuesday, April 4, 2017.
