Summer Attire

Friday, June 3rd will officially begin our summer program. Students will not have to wear uniforms during the Summer, until public school begins again on August 22nd. All children may wear regular clothing Mondays-Thursdays, but we do require tennis shoes to be worn at all times. **Vivace T-shirt with tennis shoes are required for Fridays**, but they may be worn with any bottoms.

Vivace School Jumpers

Beginning August 22nd, all enrolled girls ages 1.5-5 yrs (2T +) will be required to wear a **Vivace jumper** with a maroon polo and closed **tennis shoes** Monday-Thursday as a school uniform. **Jumpers must be embroidered with Vivace logo**, and current polos may be worn underneath. Vivace T-Shirt with khaki bottoms will remain for Fridays. **All shirts and jumpers will be available at the front office.**

Summer Childcare and After-School Program

Our center is open throughout the year, with curriculum and fine arts enrichment for children through Pre-K 4 (ages 4-5). We have the following classrooms: Infants (ages 0-1), Toddlers (1-1/2), PreK 1 (1/2-2), PreK 2A (2-2 1/2), PreK 2 (2 1/2-3), PreK 3 (3-4), PreK 4 (4-5), and school-age (6-12).

We also take enrollments for **summer care** and Christmas vacations for children ages 3-12 years.

An **after-school program** is available for children up to 12 years of age. Their program consists of a warm meal, homework time, and a daily activity.

Updating Child Records

Emergency contact information must be updated every six months. Upon August registration, a new emergency information form must be submitted in order to update each child’s record.

Please check that your child’s Immunizations are kept current, and supply us with a copy of any new vaccinations that your child may get at a doctor’s visit throughout the year. DFPS does check our records that immunizations are kept current.

The State requires that all children at 4 yrs old must have a vision and hearing test. We will be asking parents to have this completed upon each child’s fourth birthday.



\$50 Tuition Credit For Referrals



Each time you refer someone to Vivace for enrollment, you will receive \$50 tuition credit if they enroll their child full time for the school year; \$25 tuition credit if they enroll part time. Ask them to let us know that you referred them when they visit. Almost everyone is looking for child care between the months of July and early August, so feel free to let everyone know about us!
