- **Facts.org:** There are specific requirements for obtaining a high school diploma and qualifying for admission to a college or university. Florida's Academic Counseling and Tracking for Students, FACTS.org, is an online student advising system the Florida Department of Education provides to help students make informed choices about their education.
- **Bright Futures:** In order to earn the Bright Futures Scholarship, students must earn a minimum score on their SAT or ACT, must achieve a minimum GPA, and complete community service requirements (*Community Service Packets are available in the Guidance Office*).
